## Decision summary

Licence L7782/2002/6 is held by Brodan (WA) Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for the Northsands Resources premises (the Premises), located at 86 Wesco Road, Nowergup. The Premises is located within Part of Lot 6 on Diagram 34734.

The amendment has been initiated by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) to extend the duration of the licence as it is due to expire on 2 May 2024.

This amendment is limited to extending the duration of the licence and no other changes to the licence have been considered.

## Regulatory framework

In completing the assessment documented in this Amendment Report, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

## Amendment summary

The Premises relates to categories 12, 13, 62, 63, and 67A under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which is defined in existing Licence L7782/2002/6.

Licence L7782/2002/6 is due to expire on 2 May 2024, and was considered for an administrative renewal to reissue the licence for an additional 20 years which is consistent with the *Guidance Statement on Licence Duration, August 2016*.

On the 21 October 2022, DWER amended Licence L7782/2002/6 to increase the category 12 throughput and include a specifically defined area for the Class I Inert landfill however, the duration of licence was not extended.

Licence L7782/2002/6 has been extended for a further eight years in accordance with the *Guidance Statement on Licence Duration, August 2016* allowing the maximum appropriate licence term of up to 20 years. As licence L7782/2002/6 was issued on 3 May 2012 the licence expiry date will be extended to 2 May 2032.

An extension of the licence duration without a risk assessment is considered appropriate given that a full review of the licence was finalised on 21 October 2022.

## Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 8 March 2024. On 3 April 2024, the licence holder provided no comment on the draft licence and requested licence L7782/2002/6 be issued.

## Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amendment to the licence to include an extension to the licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements
