# 1. Decision summary

Licence L9272/2020/1 is held by the Water Corporation (Licence Holder) for the Dardanup Wastewater Treatment Plant (the Premises), located at Lot 20 on Deposited Plan 100642 and Part of Lot 82 on Deposited Plan 403943, Dardanup Western Australia.

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L9272/2020/1. The amendments outlined within this amendment report do not alter the risk profile of the Premises. As a result of this assessment, Revised Licence L9272/2020/1 has been granted.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The Revised Licence issued as a result of this amendment consolidates and supersedes the Existing Licence previously granted in relation to the Premises. The Revised Licence has been granted in a new format with existing conditions being transferred, but not reassessed, to the new format.

The decision report for the Existing Licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Application summary

On 13 March 2023, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L9272/2020/1 under section 59 and 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to altering the due date for the environmental report and annual audit compliance report, to be 1 October annually. In amending the licence, the CEO has:

- updated the format and appearance of the Licence; and
- corrected clerical mistakes and unintentional errors.

No changes to the aspects of the Existing Licence relating to Category 54 have been requested by the Licence Holder. Table 1 below outlines the current approved production/design capacity for the Premises.

**Table 1: Approved production/design capacity**

Category	Approved design capacity
Category 54 Sewage facility: premises — (a) on which sewage is treated (excluding septic tanks); or (b) from which treated sewage is discharged onto land or into waters.	165 m <sup>3</sup> per day

### 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 1 June 2023. Comments received from the Licence Holder on 30 June 2023, requested deletion of S8008227 and S8000216 from condition 7, stating that “S8008227 and S8000216 are not pH or flowmeters. They are internal Water Corp location references to the flume gauging station and the final effluent sample point respectively”. The Delegated Officer considers the justification provided by the Licence Holder acceptable and approves the deletion.

### 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that a Revised Licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

#### 4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 2 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised Licence as part of the amendment process.

Condition 2	Condition amended to clarify waste types and to delete ‘fuel, oil and hydrocarbons’ as they are regulated under the <i>Environmental Protection (Unauthorised Discharges) Regulations 2004</i> .
Condition 3 Table 2	Column 2 of Table 2 deleted (Waste code: K130), as the waste code doesn’t apply to sewage waste accepted through inflows.
Condition 7	Amended to specify the type of monitoring equipment used on the premises.
Condition 14	Condition reworded and updated to change the AACR reporting submission date to 1 October.
Condition 18 Table 9	Condition reworded and updated to change the Environmental Report reporting submission date to 1 October. Table 9 headings updated consistent with current revised licensing format and wording. Table 9 heading updated from ‘Annual Environmental Report’ to ‘Environmental reporting requirements’. Column headings updated from ‘Condition or table’ to ‘Condition’ and from ‘Parameter’ to ‘Requirement’. ‘Note 1: Forms are available on the Department’s website’ added beneath Table 9 and ‘Format or form’ column deleted.
Condition 19	‘Annual’ removed from ‘Annual Environmental Report’ consistent with current wording and to align with condition 18.
Definitions Table 10	Definitions updated to include ‘approved form’ and ‘condition’.
