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INTRODUCTION

Image Resources NL (Image) is seeking to develop a mineral sands mine located in the Wheatbelt region of Western Australia (WA), approximately 170 kilometres (km) north of Perth and 18 km east of Cervantes (Project). The Project occurs on Unallocated Crown Land, freehold farmland, public road reserves and within tenure issued under the Mining Act.

Image proposes to develop an open cut mine pit, processing plant, solar drying ponds and supporting infrastructure (power supply, communications, workshop, laydown, offices and accommodation camp) over an estimated mine life of approximately three years. Mining and progressive rehabilitation is planned in stages using conventional dry mineral sands mining techniques.

The Project was referred to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and it was determined to require assessment under section 39A of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (WA; EP Act), with a level of assessment of "Public Environmental Review (6 week public review)". In addition, the Project is considered to be a "controlled action" under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (Cth; EPBC Act). Section 87 of the EPBC Act makes provisions for the EPA to undertake an accredited assessment of the potential impacts to Matters of National Environmental Significance on behalf of Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water. The Project will be assessed as an 'accredited assessment' under Part IV of the EP Act. Image have released an Environmental Review Document for public environmental review and public submissions were open between 23 December 2022 and 2 February 2023.

Image submitted a Minor or Preliminary Works application for the construction of the Project's Accommodation Camp to the EPA on 21 March 2023. The Accommodation Camp will be constructed on cleared farmland owned by Image and will initially accommodate construction workers, allowing the commencement of the Project in a timely manner if approved.

The Shire of Dandaragan has approved a Development Application for the Accommodation Camp.

1.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This Works Approval Supporting Document is provided in conjunction with a Works Approval Application Form, as required under Part V Division 3 of the EP Act, for a Category 85 Sewage facility for the Project's Accommodation Camp.

The Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP), Water Treatment Plant (WTP) and spray field will be constructed at the Project's Accommodation Camp. The proposed WWTP will be used to treat and manage an estimated 21 m³ of raw wastewater effluent produced through the operation of an 82 person accommodation camp.

Raw wastewater will be processed at the WWTP before being mixed with Reverse Osmosis (RO) reject water and discharged to the environment via the irrigation spray field. The WTP will be a containerised Brackish Water RO system that will treat bore water to a potable quality according to Australian Drinking Water Guidelines. The plant is expected to treat 30 kL/day during operations. The volume of raw water that the WTP will treat will remain below the threshold of



1 ML/day and consequently will not require registration under Schedule 2 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987.

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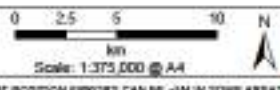
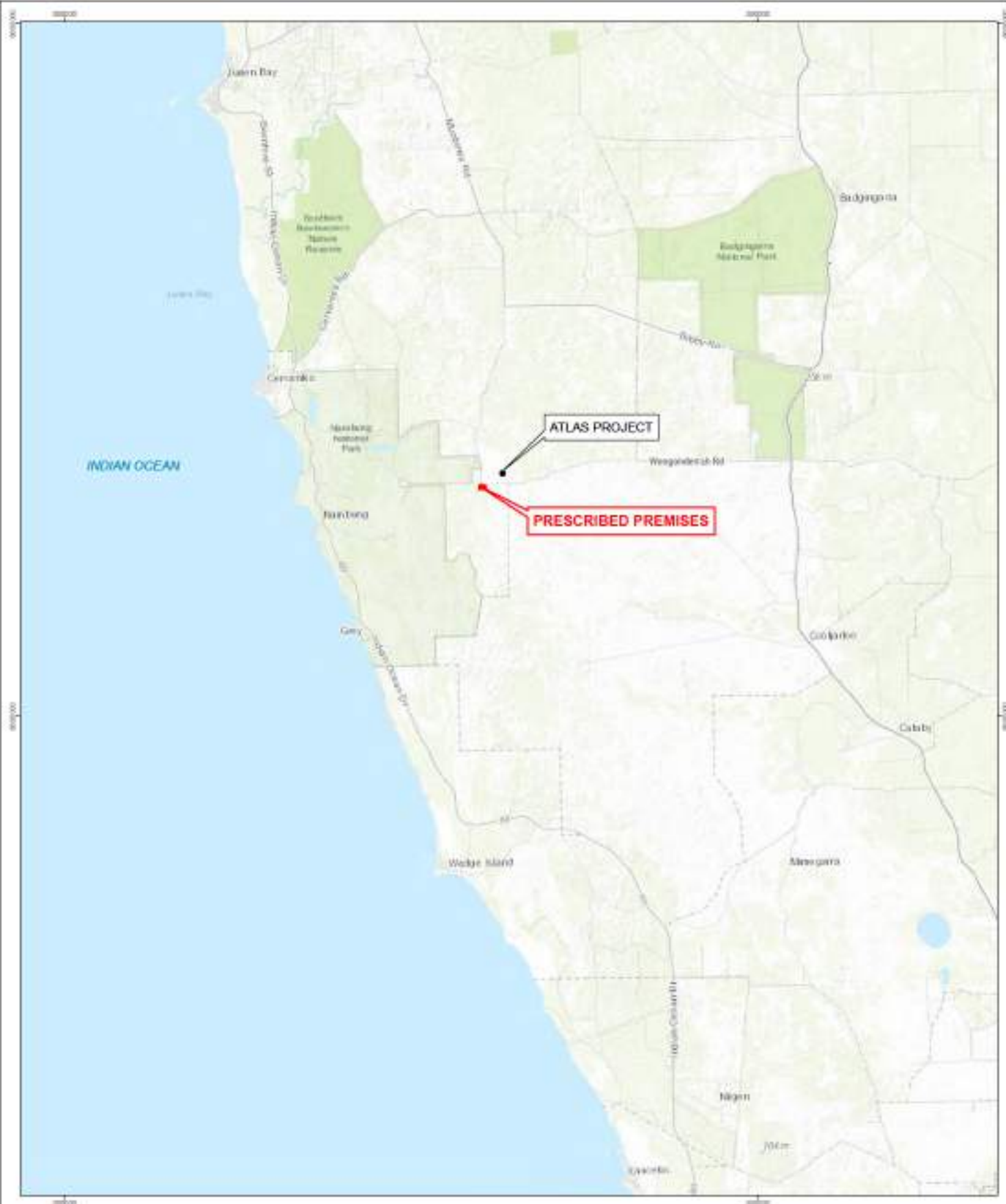

An indicative site plan for the Accommodation Camp including locations of the WWTP and spray field is provided in Figure 3.





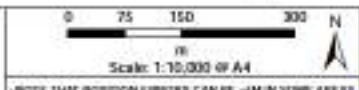
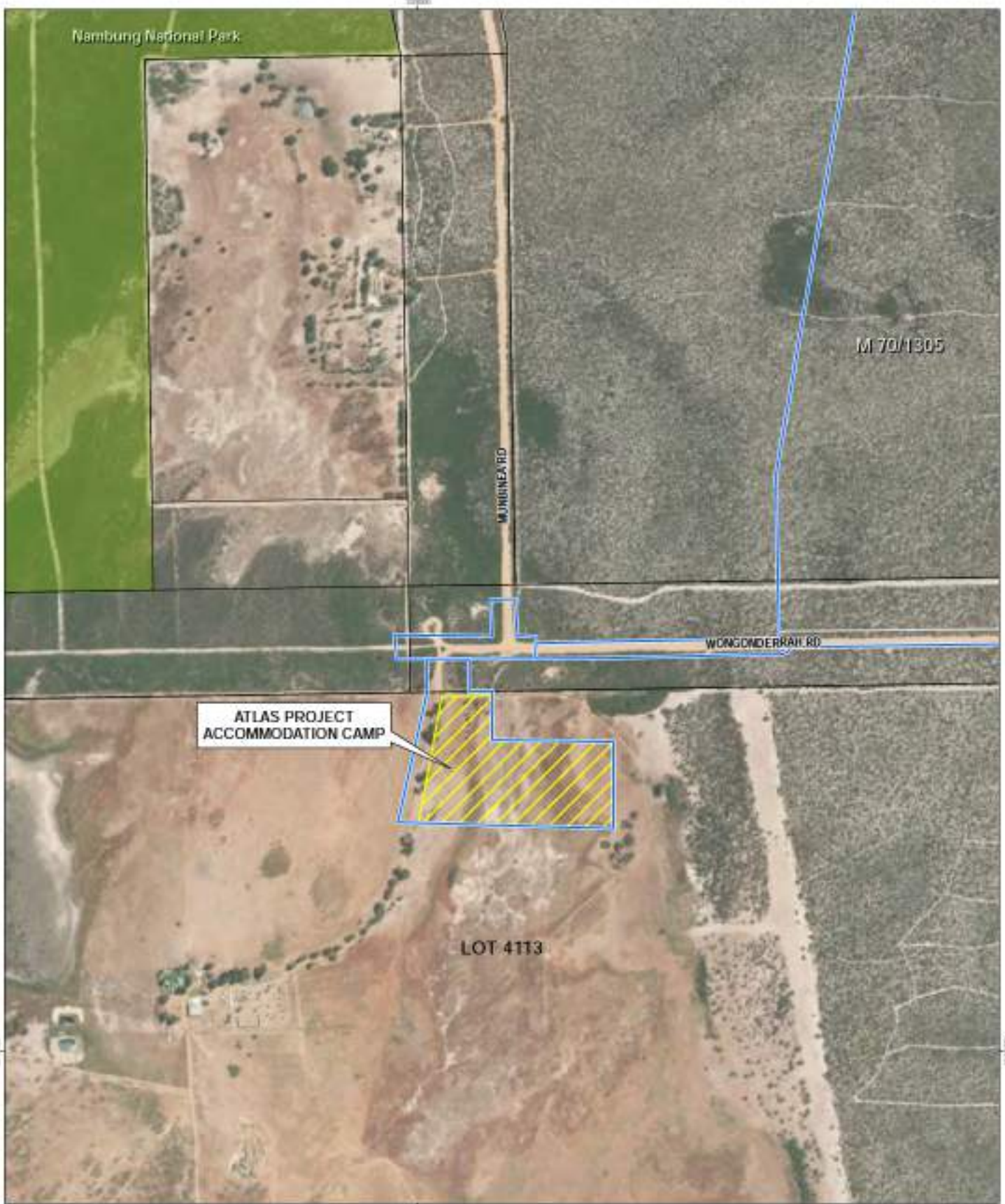

Figure 1: Regional location of the prescribed premises

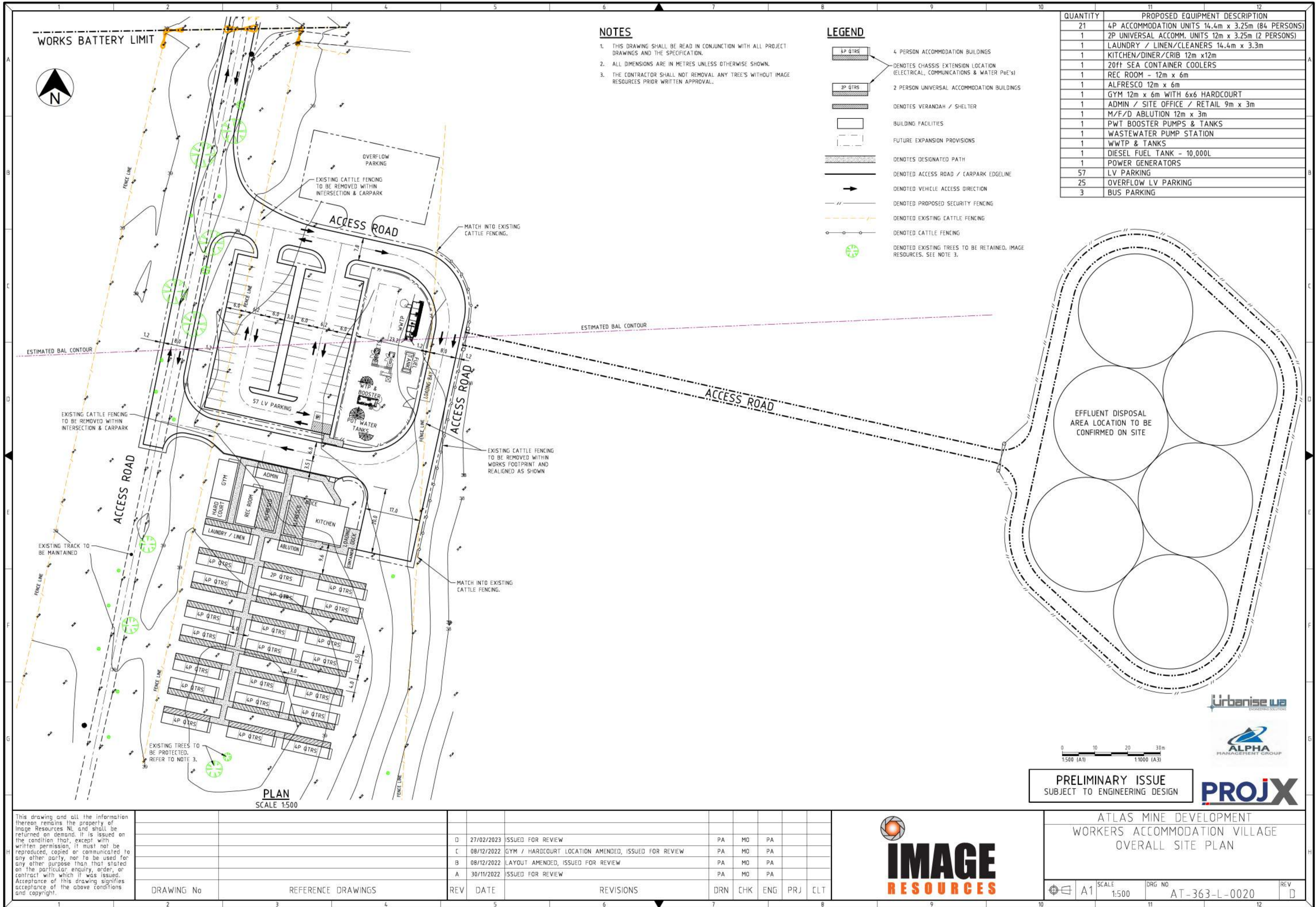

Figure 2: Prescribed premises boundary



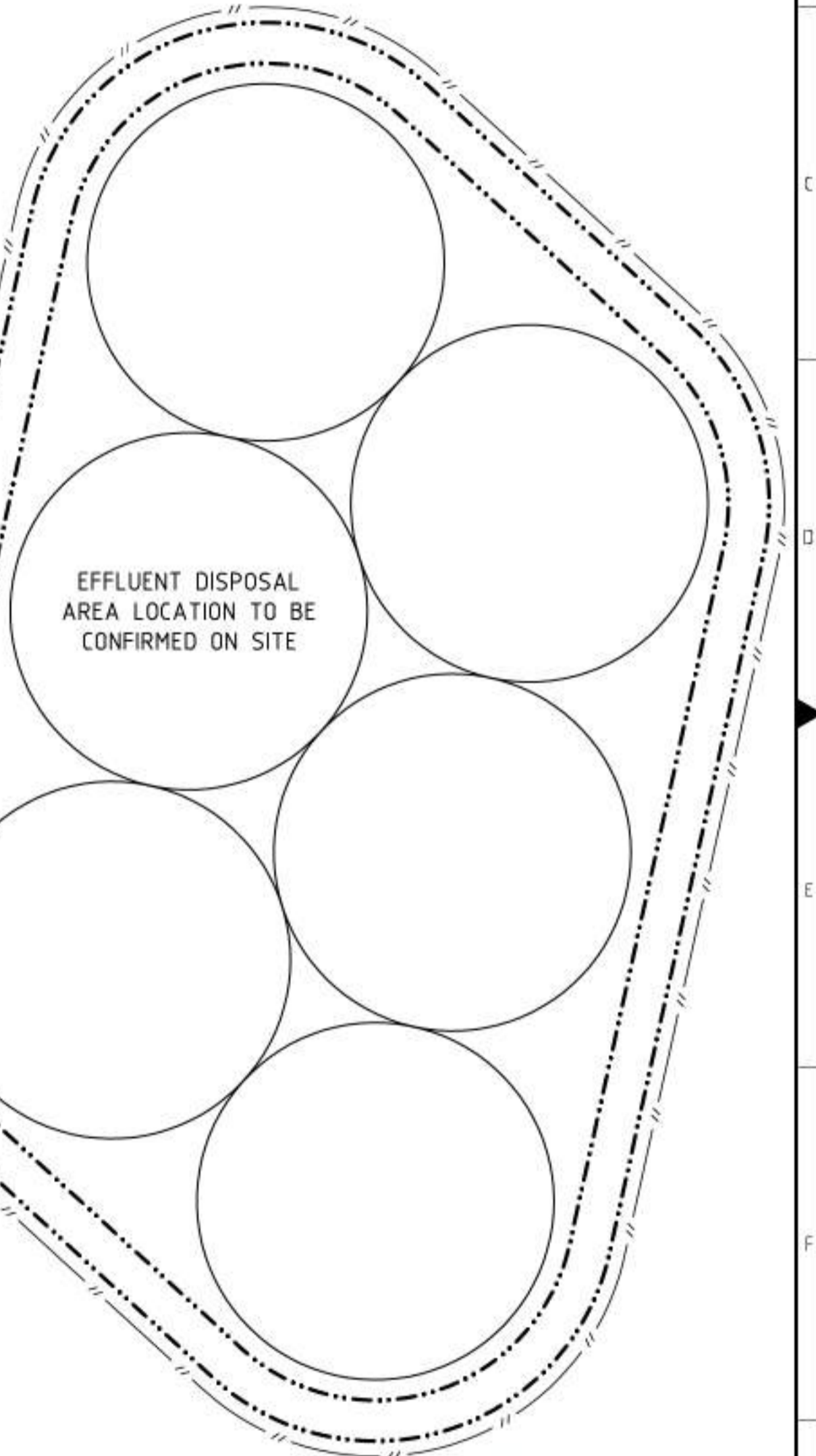

ATTACHMENT 3A: ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSIONING PLAN

3A.1 WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

The WWTP will be constructed off site and transported as modules to location. Full installation is expected to occur over approximately 2-3 weeks following delivery. Commissioning of the WWTP is expected to take up to 12 weeks as the plant requires a biological process to achieve expected effluent quality. During this time period the effluent quality will not always meet the specified effluent quality (see Section 3B2.3), however monitoring will occur during this time so changes will be detected early, and adjustments made. The spray field has been designed and sized to account for this period so concentrations will not exceed limits.

Commissioning will be carried out by a specialist engineer to ensure the supplied plant is correctly installed and functioning as per the design requirements.

3A.2 TIME LIMITED OPERATIONS

Once environmental commissioning is complete, a period of 90 days time-limited operations is proposed for the purpose of transitioning to licensed operations.



ATTACHMENT 3B: PROPOSED ACTIVITIES

3B.1 PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The WTP and WWTP are to be installed to support the Project's 82 person Accommodation Camp. The camp is expected to be in operation for a period of approximately five years.

3B.1.2 PRESCRIBED PREMISES CATEGORY

This Works Approval application has been submitted to obtain approval under Part V of the EP Act for the development of a WWTP and WTP to service the Project Accommodation Camp. Table 1 shows the relevant details and classification for the proposed, prescribed premises, under Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987.

3B.2 WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

3B.2.1 DESIGN PARAMETERS

The WWTP will be a Sequencing Batch Reactor (SBR) system custom engineered and capable of handling the peak flows and influent concentrations as detailed in Table 1. The modular system will be constructed off site in a containerised unit and is factory tested to minimise installation work on site. Installation will be a relatively simple process and minimal maintenance during operation will be required.

The WWTP design includes the following components:

- 2.5 mm bar inlet screen;
- External 32 m³ Poly balance tank;
- Balance pump;
- SBR Tank with heavy duty submersible aerators and floating decant weir;
- Decant pump;
- Worm Drive duty sludge pump;
- Internal irrigation Tank;
- Recirculation pump with online chlorine dosing;
- Sodium hypochlorite dosing system;
- Poly aluminium chloride dosing system;
- 1 x 50 kL population equivalent sludge storage tank;
- Irrigation pump;
- Discharge flow meter;
- Control panel (Australian Standard) with Programmable Logic Control and remote monitoring capabilities; and



- Audible and visual alarm.

3B2.2 PROCESS DESCRIPTION

The WWTP will be designed to treat and dispose of wastewater generated from up to 100 people, at the Project Accommodation Camp. The estimated throughput is anticipated to dispose of wastewater generated from approximately 82 people. An allowance of 250 L per person per day has been used to estimate a maximum throughput of 21 m³/day.

The WWTP will operate in a five-step mode over four, six hour cycles per day:

1. Filling of the reactor basin (0.5 hr feed / 1.25 hr anoxic period with mixing);
2. Reaction phase (3.25 hr aeration);
3. Settling phase (0.75 hr settle);
4. Decant phase (0.75 hr decant); and
5. Idle phase.

The reaction phase will be a combination of anoxic and aerobic phases to achieve high levels of biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) and nitrogen removal. The SBR tank operating volume can be adjusted for lower inflows and process sequence times will be adjustable based on influent/effluent concentrations. Treated low-risk effluent from the WWTP will be disposed to a dedicated non-human contact spray field. A process flow diagram for the WWTP is shown in Figure 4.

Housekeeping

Accommodation camp residents will be provided with information to assist in minimising the generation of wastewater and in preventing the contamination of the wastewater through the disposal of inappropriate materials. Water saving devices such as dual-flush toilets, water-saving showerheads and low water-use washing machines and dishwashers will be installed where suitable.

Power Supply

Power supply will be from diesel generators located in a dedicated service area.

Water Supply

Water supply planning for the Accommodation Camp will be treated via the WTP. Water will be supplied from licensed groundwater bores.



3B.2.3 INPUTS AND OUTPUTS

The primary input to the WWTP will be wastewater produced from the camp's toilets, bathroom, kitchen and laundry facilities. Following treatment through the plant, the wastewater will be tested against a range of parameters (Table 2) to ensure Department of Health (DoH) guidelines (DoH, 2011) are complied with. If the tests confirm that treatment has been successful, the treated effluent will be discharged to the spray field. Treated effluent that is unsuitable for discharge will be retreated.

The treatment process will include the following estimated monthly inputs:

- 100 L of Polyaluminum Chloride;
- 60 L of Sodium Hypochlorite; and
- 15 L of Sucrose.

The primary output from the WWTP will be up to 21 kL/day per day of treated (but non-potable) water of the quality outlined in Table 2. Treated wastewater will be discharged to the spray-field via sprinklers. Sludge from the WWTP will be collected by the sludge tank and periodically removed off-site by an appropriately licensed carrier.

Once the WWTP is operational, water quality monitoring will be conducted as per Table 2 to meet DoH and DWER licensing requirements. External analyses will be conducted at a National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA) accredited laboratory.

3B.3 WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The WTP will be a containerised Brackish Water Reverse Osmosis (RO) system that will treat bore water to a potable quality according to Australian Drinking Water Guidelines. The WTP is expected to treat 30 kL per day during operations.

The RO plant is complete with a membrane cleaning-in-place system. A chemical cleaning tank will batch chemical solution for membrane cleaning and membrane preservation. A pump will transfer the cleaning solution through a 5 µm bag filter to and from the membranes in the RO pressure vessels. Membrane chemical cleaning will be undertaken approximately every three-months.

3B.3.1 INPUTS AND OUTPUTS

The following input will be added to the WTP as required to maintain output water quality:

- Sodium Hypochlorite;
- Antiscalant;
- RO Acid Cleaner; and
- RO Alkaline Cleaner.

Commissioning water quality requirements for WTP input and discharge are shown in Table 3. Rejected water from the WTP will be combined with the WWTP effluent and piped to the spray-field for disposal.

* Raw water values are based on current bore data. Through the operation the supply bore may change to an alternative source which will result in minor variations to the quality of the input water. Where significant changes occur consultation with a suitably qualified person will be done to ensure that the plant is operating within the manufacturer's specifications.

3B.4 PIPING AND IRRIGATION SPRAY FIELD

Treated effluent from the WWTP and reject streams from the WTP will be disposed of via a dedicated non-human contact spray irrigation field. The irrigation pipeline will comprise a high-density polyethylene (HDPE) pipeline predominately above ground that will transport treated water to the spray field. Treated water will be discharged via above-ground sprinklers. The spray-field will be fully fenced around the perimeter to restrict access. The fence will be a



minimum of 5 m from the sprinkler spray pattern to ensure any spray drift is contained within the exclusion area.

The irrigation field will include:

- Above ground hammer cast iron type sprinklers delivering a radius of up to 30 m each with 4 mm nozzles to reduce clogging;
- 100 m of rising main from WWTP irrigation pump to dedicated spray irrigation area;
- Individual branch line flush valves;
- Automated control from WWTP irrigation pump;
- 1,200 mm high two strand steel wire perimeter fencing; and
- Safety signage displayed on perimeter fencing (every 50 m).

Effluent Quality Specifications

Wastewater will be treated to a 'low exposure risk level (ERL)' quality as outlined in the DoH *National Guidelines for Water Recycling: Managing Health and Environmental Risks 2006* (DoH Guidelines). This level of risk exposure states that potential end uses of the treated wastewater must have a low level of human contact. The treated wastewater contained in the SBR irrigation tanks will comply with the requirements of low ERL.

Low ERL parameters are described below in Table 4 as outlined in the DoH Guidelines.

Treated wastewater will be disposed of via a dedicated non-human contact spray irrigation field designed to suit a minimum of 1.23 ha plus 5.0 m spray drift buffer. To determine the appropriate minimum size of the irrigation area for wastewater disposal, Table 5 shows TP and TN loading figures calculated in line with Water Quality Protection Note (WQPN) 22 (Department of Water; DoW, 2008). Using these calculations, an irrigation area of at least 1.23 ha is required, to ensure that sufficient surface area is available to minimise the likelihood of nutrient loading.

The irrigation field will be located to the east of the accommodation camp on cleared pasture Figure 3.

3B.5 ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

Image employs several environmental and technical experts as part of mining operations. In the event that an unplanned emission/discharge occurs expert advice would be sought from a qualified professional.

Spill kits will be available for use and, in the unlikely event of a major discharge/spill, earthmoving equipment can be deployed from the nearby operation to contain the spill while investigations are occurring.

1.1.1 3B.3 MONITORING

Monitoring will be conducted throughout the commissioning process in accordance with WWTP operating manual to ensure that the plant has been configured correctly and is meeting requirements.

Once operations commence daily visual inspections will be conducted by the operator and formal monitoring will be conducted monthly including field tests, visual observation and laboratory testing to confirm compliance with Table 2 and Table 3. Residual chlorine and pH will be monitored continuously with warnings provided to operational staff if limits are breached.

1.1.2 3B.4 CONTROLS

Emissions will be managed by implementing the control actions outlined in Table 6. In the event that monitoring results show non-compliance or trending data advice will be sought from a qualified expert on how to return to compliance. Non-compliant effluent will be contained and



either re-treated or removed from site by a licensed operator for disposal. Both the WTP and the WWTP are industry standard facilities designed specifically for the inputs expected on location.

ATTACHMENT 5: OTHER APPROVALS AND CONSULTATION

5.1 OTHER APPROVALS

5.1.1 PART IV ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986

The Project is currently being formally assessed by the EPA under Part IV of the EP Act at the level of Public Environmental Review (EPA Assessment No. 2311). The Accommodation Camp (including proposed WWTP and WTP) form part of a minor or preliminary works application, which if approved will mean that they are not constrained by the Part IV EP Act process.

5.1.2 PART V ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986

No other approvals under Part V of the EP Act are required for the Accommodation Camp.

5.1.3 HEALTH ACT 1911

Image is currently applying for approval from DoH and Shire of Dandaragan for installation of the new WWTP and on-site disposal of wastewater.

5.1.4 RIGHTS IN WATER AND IRRIGATION ACT 1914

Image is currently applying for approval from DWER for 26D and 5C groundwater licences to construct a bore and take water for the Accommodation Camp water supply.

5.1.5 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2005

Image was granted an approval of a Development Application for the Accommodation Camp by the Shire of Dandaragan on 17 December 2021.

5.2 STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATION

The Image stakeholder consultation strategy through the Environmental Impact Assessment has identified key external stakeholders and determined how they will be impacted by the Project.

Commonwealth, State and Local Government authorities have been briefed on the Project in its entirety to ensure any issues, concerns or suggestions are identified and, where appropriate, addressed or responded to by Image.



The following Government Stakeholders have been consulted:

- Commonwealth Authorities:
 - Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water;
- State Authorities
 - Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions;
 - Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety;
 - DWER (EPA Services and Water); and
 - Water Corporation.
- Local Authorities
 - Shire of Dandaragan.

Image recognises that individuals, companies, and communities may also be interested in the impacts of the Project. The following corporate and community stakeholders were deemed to be relevant to this Project:

- South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council;
- Local NGOs, community groups and Yued Traditional Owners; and
- Private Land Holders (including local communities; particularly the town of Cervantes).

This works approval application will be advertised for public comment as per DWER's standard procedure.

ATTACHMENT 7: SITING AND LOCATION

The proposed WWTP will be located at the Project's Accommodation Camp on Nambung Station (Figure 2).

The WWTP is a small facility and is located in a rural location, well removed from local residences. Emissions and discharges associated with the prescribed premises are not expected to impact nearby environmentally sensitive receptors and aspects.

A significant amount of environmental baseline information has been collected for the Project throughout the Part IV EP Act and *Mining Act 1978* (WA) process. A summary of baseline information is provided below and details of the environmental impact assessment are provided in the Project's Environmental Review Document, available on the EPA website ([Atlas Project ERD](#)).

1.2 LOCAL AND REGIONAL CONTEXT

The Project is located approximately 18 km southeast of Cervantes, 12 km east of Indian Ocean Drive and 21 km west of Brand Hwy, in the Wheatbelt region of WA (Figure 1).

The Project lies within the Drummond Botanical District of the South-West Botanical Province (Beard, 1980), and comprises the Perth biogeographic subregion across majority of the disturbance footprint and some Lesueur Sandplain subregion across the northern transport corridors.

The underlying geology of the area was formed in surficial marine sediments eroded into Cretaceous basal sediments during the Pleistocene marine transgressions. The Project is predominantly comprised of pale deep Bassendean sands with areas of yellow deep sand, gravelly sands, sandy duplexes and wet soils (Desmond and Chant, 2001).

The prescribed premises is located on private land historically cleared for agriculture. Local drainage rises on the Gingin scarp 15 – 20 km to the east at a ridge line elevation of 200- 300 m. Approximately 3 km north of the prescribed premises the Mount Jetty and Bibby Creeks flood-out across an area of very low surface gradients. The creek-lines reform and coalesce to the west as the Nambung River, which discharges into Tamala Limestone 6 km east of the coast. Notable landscape features in proximity to the prescribed premises include Nambung National Park, Wongonderrah Nature Reserve and Nambung River.

1.3 LAND USE

The Project lies on land held by the Yued People, who have lived on approximately 29,000 km² of country between Yanchep and Coolimba for an estimated 40,000 years. The Project lies within the Yued Native Title (1997) determination area. Image have engaged Yued representatives to conduct several aboriginal heritage surveys of the Project area and not Registered or Other Aboriginal Heritage sites have been recorded within or in proximity to the prescribed premises.

The prescribed premises is located on private land historically cleared for agriculture. The dominant land surrounding the prescribed premises includes areas of remnant bushland, dry-



land agriculture, conservation and Unallocated Crown Land. The greater agricultural area is located between the Badgingarra and Nambung National Parks.

7.1 NEARBY ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE RECEPTORS AND ASPECTS

Four residences are located within 5 km of the WWTP (Table 7; Figure 5). All residences are primarily working farm properties. Nambung Station has been purchased by Image to be utilised for the Project and the remaining properties are privately owned.

There are no conservation reserves or other Environmentally Sensitive Areas, as defined under section 51B of the EP Act or any listed or proposed wetlands of national or international importance over the proposed prescribed premises.

The prescribed premises is not located within a 'Specified Ecosystem' as described in Environmental Siting Guidance Statement (Department of Environment Regulation, 2016).

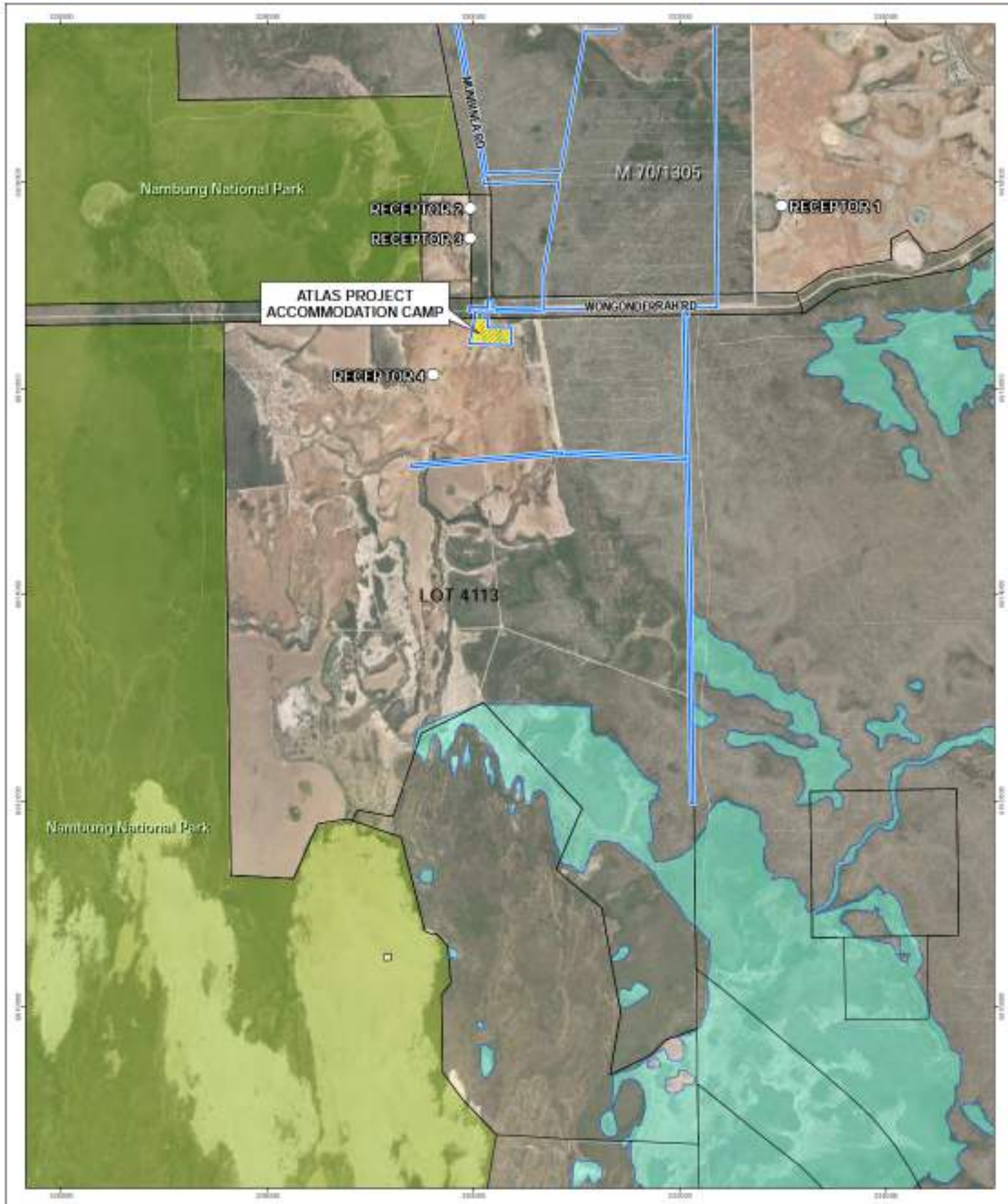
The Lancelin Defence Training Area wetland system, listed in the Directory of Important Wetlands in Australia (WA119) covers approximately 25,000 ha and extends for approximately 30 km north from near Lancelin to the area located approximately 3.5 km to the south and southeast of the prescribed premises. This wetland system is considered part of the regionally significant Bassendean Group and is recognised for its conservation values.

The eastern boundary of Nambung National Park is located approximately 600 m to the northwest of the prescribed premises. The main public access to the park is from Indian Ocean Drive to the west. The Nambung National Park Visitor Centre is located approximately 10 km southwest of the prescribed premises.

A portion of the area surrounding the prescribed premises is mapped by DBCA as 'Banksia Dominated Woodlands of the Swan Coastal Plain' TEC (EPBC Act). Surveys for the Project mapped '*Banksia attenuata*, *Banksia menziesii* low woodlands' and '*Banksia prionotes* low woodlands' within the native vegetation surrounding the prescribed premises.

The prescribed premises lies within the range of the Carnaby's Cockatoo (Endangered; *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* (WA) and EPBC Act). Carnaby's Cockatoo were recorded within the survey areas for the Project and very high quality foraging habitat was mapped within the native vegetation surrounding the prescribed premises. No Carnaby's Cockatoo habitat has been recorded within the prescribed premises.
