1. Scope of amendment

1.1 Amendment summary

Charla Downs Pty Ltd (licence holder) hold licence L2/2008/2, issued under Part V Division 3 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*. The licence is due to expire on 16 April 2024.

The licence relates to operation of a cattle feedlot about 3 km west of the Waroona townsite. The main activities occurring on the premises include the holding and feeding of cattle, and management of manure and mortalities generated from operations.

The department has previously indicated its intentions to review the licence as part of replacing the expiring licence in 2024, including an audit of the design and operational aspects of the feedlot against the *National Beef Cattle Feedlot Environmental Code of Practice* (MLA 2012) (Code). However, due to time constraints, the department has been unable to commence the review before the current licence expires.

2. Decision

The delegated officer has determined to extend the duration of the existing licence as an administrative change, on the grounds of time constraints to complete a detailed review, and that it does not change the obligations of the licence holder in the interim.

The licence duration will be extended by 12 months, now expiring in 2025, in which time it is anticipated the department will have completed its review of the licence, taking into consideration a self-audit of the feedlot against the Code that has been conducted by the licence holder.

In extending licence duration, the delegated officer has also determined to make administrative changes, as detailed in the below table.

3. Consultation

The draft licence and this report were provided to the licence holder on 12 April 2024 and waived the consultation period with no additional comments.

3.1 Summary of changes
