### 1. Decision Summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to transfer Licence L8452/2010/2 to Castle Equipment Hire Pty Ltd. The transfer is administrative in nature therefore does not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

## 2. Scope of Assessment

#### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In completing the assessment documented in this decision report, the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (the department; DWER) has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <a href="https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents">https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents</a>.

### 2.2 Application summary

On 20 February 2024, the applicant submitted an application to transfer a licence to the department under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) for Castle Equipment Hire Pty Ltd (Premises) from Dugite Earthmoving Pty Ltd.

The premises relates to category 12, crushing and screening of material and assessed production / design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations* 1987 (EP Regulations) which are defined in Licence L8452/2010/2.

The Premises is licenced to process 50 000 tonnes or more per annual period of material.

This Licence was recently transferred once before on 22 June 2023 where the department revised licence conditions and removed any redundant conditions. The format and appearance of the licence was also updated.

#### 3. Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined the transfer of the licence is an administrative change which does not alter the risk profile of the premises. Therefore, following a review of the supporting documentation including the ASIC business registration details, the Delegated Officer has determined to transfer the licence from Dugite Earthmoving Pty Ltd to Castle Equipment Hire Pty Ltd.
