## 1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L8665/2012/2. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8665/2012/2 is held by BHP Billiton Iron Ore Pty Ltd (licence holder) for the Warrawandu Village Wastewater Treatment Plant (the premises), located within a portion of mining lease ML244SA.

The premises relates to the category and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 which are defined in existing licence L8665/2012/2.

On 1 July 2025, the department initiated an amendment to licence L8665/2012/2. This amendment is limited to correcting typographical errors, specifically the unintended omission of the ambient groundwater monitoring point reference, location, and frequency - including total suspended solids (mg/L) as a parameter - from Condition 17, Table 7 of the previously issued licence.

## 3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 20 August 2025.

On 22 August 2025 the licence holder waived the comment period.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the delegated officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
