
While commissioning the GW WWTP inlet pond (L2) on 25/06/2021, a leak was identified by the environmental advisor on-site. The effluent material was contained and removed.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

The effluent caused minor pooling outside of the containment structure. The environmental impact was minimal.

On 09/06/2021 an IT operator clipped the tailings return line whilst conducting roadworks at the Barminco office complex.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

A volume discharged from the return water line is estimated to be 40 8m³. The area impacted was 1066m² of existing disturbance. WAD cyanide results of return water on 27/05/2021 were 0.033 mg/L.
