Interpretation

In this Licence:

- (a) the words 'including', 'includes' and 'include' will be read as if followed by the words 'without limitation';
- (b) where any word or phrase is given a defined meaning, any other part of speech or other grammatical form of that word or phrase has a corresponding meaning;
- (c) where tables are used in a Condition, each row in a table constitutes a separate Condition;
- (d) any reference to an Australian or other standard, guideline or code of practice in this Licence means the version of the standard, guideline or code of practice in force at the time of granting of this Licence and includes any amendments to the standard, guideline or code of practice which may occur from time to time during the course of the Licence; and
- (e) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act.

NOTE: This licence requires specific conditions to be met but does not provide any implied authorisation for other emissions, discharges, or activities not specified in this licence.

Licence conditions

The licence holder must ensure that the following conditions are complied with:

Infrastructure and equipment (Operation)

1. The Licence Holder must ensure that the site infrastructure and equipment listed in Table 2 is maintained and operated in accordance with the corresponding operational requirements set out in Table 2.

Waste type restrictions and waste classification

- **2.** The Licence Holder must only accept onto the Premises waste of a waste type, which:
 - (a) does not exceed the corresponding rate at which waste is received; and
 - (b) which meets the corresponding acceptance specification; as set out in Table 3.

Monitoring of waste inputs

- **3.** The Licence Holder must monitor and record the volumes of incoming waste at the Premises for:
 - (a) the parameters stipulated;
 - (b) using the units specified; and
 - (c) at the frequency specified;

Closure Requirements

- **4.** The Licence Holder must ensure the following post closure specifications for the Premises are met:
 - (a) all landfilled waste shall be covered with a final capping of at least 1,000mm of Clean Fill;
 - (b) the final height of the capped landfill shall be consistent with the natural ground level; and
 - (c) the final landform design shall consider the flow of surface water to minimise erosion and surface water ponding.

Record-keeping

- **5.** The Licence Holder must maintain accurate and auditable Books including the following records, information, reports and data required by this Licence:
 - (a) the calculation of fees payable in respect of this Licence;
 - (b) the maintenance of infrastructure required to ensure that it is kept in good working order in accordance with Condition 1 of this Licence;
 - (c) monitoring undertaken in accordance with Condition 3 of this Licence;
 - (d) the closure requirements undertaken in accordance with Condition 4 of this Licence; and
 - (e) complaints received under Condition 6 of this Licence.


In addition, the Books must:

- (f) be legible;
- (g) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original and subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
- (h) be retained for at least 3 years from the date the Books were made; and
- (i) be available to be produced to an Inspector or the CEO.
- 6. The Licence Holder must record the number and details of any complaints received by the Licence Holder relating to its obligations under this Licence and its compliance with Part V of the EP Act at the Premises, and any action taken by the Licence Holder in response to the complaint. Details of complaints must include:
 - (a) an accurate record of the concerns or issues raised, for example a copy of any written complaint or a written note of any verbal complaints made;
 - (b) the name and contact details of the complainant, if provided by the complainant;
 - (c) the date of the complaint; and
 - (d) the details and dates of the actions taken by the Licence Holder in response to the complaints.
- **7.** The licence holder must:
 - (a) undertake an audit of their compliance with the conditions of this licence during the preceding annual period; and
 - (b) prepare and submit to the CEO by no later than 1 October an Annual Audit Compliance Report, in the approved form, indicating the extent to which the Licence Holder has complied with the Conditions in this Licence for the preceding Annual Period.


Premises map 1
