Record-keeping

The licensee shall by **1 March** in each year, provide to the CEO an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the form in Attachment 3 to this licence, signed and certified in the manner required by Section C of the form, indicating the extent to which the licensee has complied with the conditions of this licence, and any previous licence issued under Part V of the Act for the premises, during the period beginning 1 February the previous year and ending on 31 January in that year.


Notification of intention to dispose
