The licence holder must ensure that the following conditions are complied with:

Emissions and discharges

Air emissions

1. The Licence Holder shall, after six months of achieving stable, normal operation, provide to the CEO a plume dispersion model of NO_X emissions from the 2.75MW Thermic Industries W300 steam boiler stack using real sampling data under normal operating conditions.

Records and reporting

- 2. The Licence Holder must submit a detailed description of planned operations within the premises to the Department 6 months prior to recommencement of operations. The description must include the following information:
 - (a) Infrastructure and equipment details;
 - (b) Description of processes or operations;
 - (c) Production or design capacity details;
 - (d) Description of emission / discharge points;
 - (e) Locations of waste storage or disposal;
 - (f) Estimated operating period.
- 3. The licence holder must record the following information in relation to complaints received by the licence holder (whether received directly from a complainant or forwarded to them by the Department or another party) about any alleged emissions from the premises:
 - (a) the name and contact details of the complainant, (if provided);
 - (b) the time and date of the complaint;
 - (c) the complete details of the complaint and any other concerns or other issues raised; and
 - (d) the complete details and dates of any action taken by the licence holder to investigate or respond to any complaint.
- **4.** The licence holder must:
 - (a) undertake an audit of their compliance with the conditions of this licence during the preceding annual period; and
 - (b) prepare and submit to the CEO by no later than 30 days after the end of that annual period an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the approved form.
- **5.** The licence holder must maintain accurate and auditable books including the following records, information, reports, and data required by this licence:
 - (a) the calculation of fees payable in respect of this licence;
 - (b) monitoring programmes undertaken in accordance with condition 1 of this licence; and
 - (c) complaints received under condition 32 of this licence.
- **6.** The books specified under condition 5 must:
 - (a) be legible;
 - (b) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original version(s) and any subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
 - (c) be retained by the licence holder for the duration of the licence; and
 - (d) be available to be produced to an inspector or the CEO as required.
