Interpretation

 - (i) if dated, refers to that particular version; and
 - (ii) if not dated, refers to the latest version and therefore may be subject to change over time;
- (e) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act; and
- (f) unless specified otherwise, all definitions are in accordance with the EP Act.

NOTE: This licence requires specific conditions to be met but does not provide any implied authorisation for other emissions, discharges, or activities not specified in this licence.

Licence conditions

The licence holder must ensure that the following conditions are complied with:

Infrastructure and equipment

1. The licence holder must ensure that the site infrastructure and equipment listed in Table 1 and located at the corresponding infrastructure location is maintained and operated in accordance with the corresponding operational requirement set out in Table 1.

Emissions

2. The licence holder must manage dust generation at the premises by wetting down unsealed roads and exposed areas with a water truck.

Records and reporting

3. The licence holder must maintain accurate and auditable books including the following records, information, reports, and data required by this licence:
 - (a) the calculation of fees payable in respect of this licence;
 - (b) any maintenance of infrastructure that is performed in the course of complying with condition 1 of this licence; and
 - (c) complaints received under condition 5 of this licence.
4. The books specified under condition 3 must:
 - (a) be legible;
 - (b) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original version(s) and any subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
 - (c) be retained by the licence holder for the duration of the licence; and

- (d) be available to be produced to an inspector or the CEO as required.
- 5. The licence holder must record the following information in relation to complaints received by the licence holder (whether received directly from a complainant or forwarded to them by the Department or another party) about any alleged emissions from the premises:
 - (a) the name and contact details of the complainant, (if provided);
 - (b) the time and date of the complaint;
 - (c) the complete details of the complaint and any other concerns or other issues raised; and
 - (d) the complete details and dates of any action taken by the licence holder to investigate or respond to any complaint.
- 6. The licence holder must:
 - (a) undertake an audit of their compliance with the conditions of this licence during the preceding annual period; and
 - (b) prepare and submit to the CEO by no later than 30 days after the end of that annual period an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the approved form.

Construction requirements

- 7. The licence holder must install the equipment:
 - (a) in accordance with the corresponding design and installation requirements; and
 - (b) at the corresponding infrastructure location;as set out in Table 2.

Compliance reporting

- 8. The licence holder must within 30 calendar days of an item of infrastructure or equipment required by condition 7 being installed prepare and submit to the CEO an Environmental Compliance Report on that compliance.
- 9. The Environmental Compliance Report required by condition 9, must include as a minimum the following:
 - (a) certification by a person authorised to represent the licence holder that the infrastructure or component(s) thereof, as specified in condition 7, have been constructed in accordance with the relevant requirements specified in condition 7;
 - (b) photographs that clearly indicate that the infrastructure has been constructed as per requirement specified in condition 7; and
 - (c) be signed by a person authorised to represent the licence holder and contains the printed name and position of that person.
