### Interpretation

In this licence:

### **Licence conditions**

1. The licence holder shall ensure that all activities identified in Table 1. are undertaken in accordance with the process limits described in that Table.

Iron, steel, zinc and stainless steel	Flame cutting	All rubber lining and surface treatments are removed from scrap metal prior to flame cutting.
	Metal melting and casting	Only clean scrap metal shall be melted.

#### **Records and reporting**

- 2. All information and records required by the Licence shall:
  - (a) be legible;
  - (b) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original version(s) and any subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
  - (c) be retained by the licence holder for the duration of the licence; and
  - (d) be available to be produced to an inspector or the CEO as required.
- 3. The licence holder must:
  - (a) undertake an audit of their compliance with the conditions of this licence during the preceding annual period; and
  - (b) prepare and submit to the CEO an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the approved form by 31 August each year.
- 4. The licence holder must record the following information in relation to complaints received by the licence holder (whether received directly from a complainant or forwarded to them by the Department or another party) about any alleged emissions from the premises:
  - (a) the name and contact details of the complainant, (if provided);
  - (b) the time and date of the complaint;
  - (c) the complete details of the complaint and any other concerns or other issues raised; and
  - (d) the complete details and dates of any action taken by the licence holder to investigate or respond to any complaint.




Figure 1: Map of the boundary of the prescribed premises

The boundary of the prescribed premises is shown in the map below (Figure 1).
