You are hereby advised that a licence under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (the Act) has been granted for the above premises. The Department of Environment and Conservation will advertise the issuing of this licence in the public notices section of The West Australian newspaper.

The licence is subject to the attached conditions. Under section 58 of the Act, it is an offence to contravene a licence condition. This offence carries a penalty of up to \$125,000, with a daily penalty of up to \$25,000.

In accordance with section 102(1)(c) of the Act, you are afforded 21 days to appeal the conditions of the licence. Under section 102(3)(a) of the Act, any other person may also appeal the conditions of the licence.

DEFINITIONS

In these conditions of licence, unless inconsistent with the text or subject matter:

"licensed" means licensed under the Environmental Protection Act 1986;

"NATA" means the National Association of Testing Authorities;

"AS/NZS5667 or Australian Standard 5667" means the most recent version and the relevant parts of the Australian and New Zealand series of guidance standards on Water Quality Sampling;

"premises" means Part Lot 22 on Diagram 88339, Mason Road, KWINANA BEACH, WA, 6167 as depicted in Attachment 1; and

"quarterly" means each 3 calendar month period commencing on 1 January, 1 April, 1 July, and 1 October each year.

All other terms take their meaning from the Environmental Protection Act 1986.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1(a) The licensee shall advise the Director in writing within 24 hours of becoming aware of an exceedance of any measurement which indicates that any discharge limit specified in these conditions of licence has been exceeded.
- 1(b) The licensee shall provide a full report on its investigations into any exceedance reported under condition 1(a) within 7 days of that exceedance, and it shall include, but not be limited to:
 - (i) the date, time, and reason for the exceedance;
 - (ii) the period over which the exceedance occurred;
 - (iii) the nature and extent of the discharge over that period and potential or known environmental consequences;
 - (iv) corrective action taken or planned to mitigate adverse environmental consequences; and
 - (v) corrective action taken or planned to prevent a recurrence of the exceedance.

EMISSION TO AIR

- 2. The licensee shall ensure that, during normal operation, waste gases from the premises are only discharged to the environment through the following discharge points:
 - (i) major gaseous waste through the chlorine absorption tower vents, HCl gas scrubbers, steam boiler chimneys, and hydrogen safety seal vents; and
 - (ii) minor process waste gases through various tank and process vessel vents.
- 3(a) The licensee shall ensure that all emission monitoring required by any condition of this licence is conducted in accordance with Table 1.

- 3(b) The licensee shall record results of monitoring required by condition 3(a) of this licence and shall retain those records on site for at least six months after the emission occurred.
- 3(c) The licensee shall maintain the continuous emissions monitoring systems specified in this licence to provide reliable and accurate data for:
 - (i) greater than 90 percent of the time that waste gasses are emitted from the specified stack in every calendar month period; and
 - (ii) greater than 95 percent of the time that waste gasses are emitted from the specified equipment in any period of twelve consecutive calendar months.
- 4 The licensee shall ensure that discharges of chlorine from the sources listed in column 1 of Table 2, for the concentration ranges specified in column 2 of Table 2, do not occur for continuous time periods longer than those specified in column 3 of Table 2.

- 5 The licensee shall operate the HCl synthesis units with hydrogen to chlorine feed to the burner ratio between 10% and 15% excess hydrogen over the stoichiometric requirement so that there is no free chlorine in the vent gas.
- 6 The licensee shall operate the HCl synthesis units so that any over-pressure caused by an internal ignition will invoke an automatic shutdown and isolation of the chlorine and hydrogen feeds.

MONITORING CONDITIONS

- 7. The licensee shall, on a quarterly basis, take representative groundwater samples from the monitoring bores shown in Attachment 3 and analyse the samples for pH and conductivity.
- 8. The licensee shall ensure that all groundwater samples, that are required by this licence, are collected in accordance with Australian Standard 5667.
- 9. The licensee shall ensure that all groundwater samples, that are required by this licence, are submitted to a laboratory with current NATA registration for the analyses specified.

REPORTING CONDITIONS

- 10. The licensee shall by 1 July in each year, provide to the Director an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the form in Attachment 4 to this licence, signed and certified in the manner required by Section C of the form, indicating the extent to which the licensee has complied with the conditions of this licence, and any previous licence issued under Part V of the Act for the premises, during the period beginning 1 May the previous year and ending on 30 April in that year.
- 11. The licensee shall provide to the Director, by 1 July each year, an Annual Monitoring Report. This report shall cover the previous 12 month period from 1 May to 30 April containing the monitoring data or other collected data required by any condition of this licence and be submitted to the Director.
- 12. The report required by condition 1(a) shall include an assessment of the data against any limits set in this licence or other environmental guidelines or policies and data from previous years' monitoring. It shall identify any data exceeding those limits, guidelines or policies and provide information on why the exceedance occurred (if known) and action taken by the licensee to prevent recurrence of such exceedances.
