A licence under the Environmental Protection Act 1986 (the Act) has been granted for the above premises. The Department of Environmental Regulation will advertise the issuing of this licence in the public notices section of *The West Australian* newspaper.

The licence includes attached conditions. Under Section 58(1) of the Act, it is an offence to contravene a condition of a licence. This offence carries a penalty of up to \$125,000 and a daily penalty of up to \$25,000

In accordance with section 102(1)(c) of the Act, you have 21 days to appeal the conditions of the licence. Under section 102(3)(a) of the Act, any other person may also appeal the conditions of the licence. To lodge an appeal contact the Office of the Appeals Convenor on 6467 5190 or by email at admin@appealsconvenor.wa.gov.au.

Where a licence is issued for more than one year it requires payment of an annual fee and will cease to have effect if the fee is unpaid. It is the occupier's responsibility to lodge a fee application and pay the annual fee in sufficient time to avoid incurring a late payment fee and for processing to be completed before the licence anniversary date. GENERAL CONDITIONS

ANNUAL ENVIRONMENTAL REPORT

- G1 The licensee shall provide to the Director by 1 September each year, an Annual Environmental Report containing data collected during the period beginning 1 July the previous year and ending on 31 June in that year. The report shall contain, but not be limited to:
 - (i) monitoring data and other collected data required by any condition of this licence (data should be provided in tables and in graphical format);
 - (ii) an explanation of the monitoring data and other collected data required by any condition of this licence:
 - (a) in comparison with past monitoring data collected for the previous three (3) years; and
 - (b) known standards;
 - (iii) a summary of the number and type of complaints received, nature of complaint (cross referenced with prevailing wind directions), and action taken;
 - (iv) any issues raised from inspections or incident responses during the reporting period together with details as to how these have been addressed / rectified or, if the required work has yet to be completed, how and when they will be completed / rectified; and
 - (v) any changes to site boundaries, location of groundwater monitoring bores, surface drainage channels and on-site or off-site impacts or pollution.

ANNUAL AUDIT COMPLIANCE REPORT

G2 The licensee shall by 1 September in each year, provide to the Director an annual audit compliance report in the form in Attachment 1 to this licence, signed and certified in the manner required by Section C of the form, indicating the extent to which the licensee has complied with the conditions of this licence, and any previous licence issued under Part V of the Act for the premises, during the period beginning 1 July the previous year and ending on 31 June in that year.

DISCHARGE TO WATER

MAINTENANCE OF WASTEWATER TREATMENT PONDS

- W1 The licensee shall manage the wastewater treatment ponds in a manner such that:
 - (i) uncontaminated stormwater resulting from site drainage shall be prevented from entering the wastewater treatment stream or causing erosion of outer pond embankments;
 - (ii) overtopping of the wastewater ponds shall not occur;
 - (iii) there is no discernible seepage loss from the wastewater treatment ponds or storage ponds;
 - (iv) floating debris and vegetation (emergent or otherwise) is removed and prevented from growing in the wastewater ponds; and
 - (v) trapped overflows shall be maintained on the discharge from all wastewater treatment ponds to prevent carry over of surface floating matter to subsequent ponds.

FLOW MONITORING DEVICE

- W2(a) The licensee shall maintain an accurate metering device for measuring the cumulative volume of treated wastewater discharged from the discharge point DP1, as depicted in Attachment 2.
- W2(b) The licensee shall, using the measuring device required by condition W2(a), measure the monthly cumulative volume of treated wastewater (in cubic metres) discharged from the discharge point DP1.

MONITORING REQUIREMENTS

W3 The licensee shall, at the frequencies stated in column 2 of Table 1, take and have analysed representative water samples for the parameters listed in column 3 of Table 1, from the monitoring sites listed in column 1 of Table 1.

With the exception of pH and E. coli, all measurements shall be reported in mg/L.

SAMPLE ANALYSIS

- W4(a) The licensee shall ensure that all water samples are collected, handled and preserved in accordance with the relevant parts of AS/NZS 5667.
- W4(b) The licensee shall ensure that all water samples are analysed in accordance with the current "Standard Methods for Examination of Water and Wastewater," APHA-AWWA-WEF.
- W4(c) The licensee shall ensure all water samples are analysed in a laboratory holding NATA accreditation for the analyses specified in condition W3.

CALCULATION OF CONTAMINANT LOAD

- W5 The licensee shall, using the data collected in accordance with conditions W3, W4(a) to W4(c), determine the monthly load of the following parameters in wastewater discharged from the premises:
 - (i) Total Dissolved Solids;
 - (ii) Total Suspended Solids;
 - (iii) 5-Day Biochemical Oxygen Demand;
 - (iv) Total Nitrogen; and
 - (v) Total Phosphorus.

All measurements are to be reported in kilograms per day (kg/day).

MANAGEMENT OF LAND DISPOSAL AREAS

- W6 The licensee shall manage the land disposal area such that:
 - (i) the distribution of treated wastewater is maximised; and
 - (ii) effluent channels are kept clear of excessive sludge build-up.

SOLID WASTE POLLUTION CONTROL CONDITIONS

POND AND SOLIDS MANAGEMENT

- S1(a) The licensee shall dispose of collected vegetation and floating debris from the treatment ponds to a licensed landfill.
- S1(b) The licensee shall:
 - (i) inform the Director no less than seventy-two (72) hours prior to taking a treatment pond offline for maintenance works;
 - (ii) inform the Director no less than fourteen (14) days prior to the removal of sewage sludge from a treatment pond; and
 - (iii) where sewage sludge is temporarily stored on-site, direct sewage sludge to a hardstand area which:
 - (a) is adequately bunded to prevent surface runoff of leachate or sludge from crossing the boundary of the premises; and
 - (b) returns sludge leachate from the storage area back to the treatment ponds.
