Applicability

This licence is issued to Red Sand Supplies and Earth Moving Contractors Pty Ltd for operation of a building materials crushing and screening facility located at the corner of San Miguel and Hope Valley Roads, Hope Valley which is a prescribed premises within Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987*, and includes but is not necessarily limited, the following operations:

Crushing and screening of building material

This facility is prescribed within Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 as outlined in Table 1;

13	Crushing of building material	Premises on which waste building or demolition material; (for example, bricks, stones, or concrete) is crushed or cleaned.

Other Legal Requirements

The licensee should be aware that these conditions do not exempt the Licensee from other statutory obligations under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*, or any other Acts. This includes the licensee's obligations under the:

- Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (as amended); and
- Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997.

Where there is conflict between the conditions set in this licence and any Act or Regulations, the latter takes precedence.

Non-Standard Operations

The licensee should inform the Department of Environment and Conservation at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of any planned non-standard operations which may have the potential to cause pollution.

Emergency, Accident or Malfunction

The licensee should inform the Director within 2 normal working days of the identification of any discharge of waste which has occurred as a result of an emergency, accident or malfunction, or extreme weather conditions, otherwise than in accordance with any condition of this Licence and has caused or is likely to cause pollution.

General Requirements

The following statements paraphrase sections of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* and are included for the information of the licensee.

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- The licensee should take all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent pollution of the environment.
- Noise emissions from operations on site are required to comply with the Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997.
- The licensee shall take all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent or minimise the emission of odours from the premises.

Alteration to Premises

Prior to making any significant alterations to the premises which may affect the air, water or noise emissions from the premises the Licensee must submit a proposal to the Director accompanied by supporting information and plans which allow the environmental impact of that change to be assessed.

In these conditions of licence, unless inconsistent with the text or subject matter, the following definitions apply:

"DEC Asbestos Guidelines" means the current version of the *Guidelines for managing* asbestos at construction and demolition waste recycling facilities;

AIR POLLUTION CONTROL CONDITIONS

CRUSHING AND SCREENING

A1 The Licensee shall ensure that no visible dust generated as a result of the crushing and screening activities crosses the boundary of the premises.

STOCKPILES

A2(a) The licensee shall prevent dust lift-off from non-working faces of stockpiles and open areas by using appropriate dust suppression techniques, including but not limited to water sprays, sprinklers and water cannons.

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A2(b) The licensee shall minimise dust lift-off from working faces of stockpiles by using appropriate dust suppression techniques, including but not limited to water sprays, sprinklers and cannons.

TRAFFICKED AREAS

A3 ·

The licensee shall ensure water trucks or sprinklers are used to wet sealed and unsealed roads, access ways and trafficked areas so that no visible dust crosses the boundary of the premises.
