# CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

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### DEFINITIONS

In these conditions of licence, unless inconsistent with the text or subject matter:

“AACR” means Annual Audit Compliance Report, the template of which can be found on the DWER’s website [www.dwer.wa.gov.au](http://www.dwer.wa.gov.au)

“Australian Standard 1940-2004” means the most recent version of the Australian Standard for The storage and handling of flammable and combustible liquids;

“CEO” for the purpose of correspondence means:

“Department” means the department established under section 35 of the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* and designated as responsible for the administration of Part V, Division 3 of the EP Act;

“DWER” means the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation;

“Licence” means this Licence, numbered L9125/2018/1 and issued under the Act for the replacement of previously ceased licence L8674/2012/1 including amendments.

“Code of Practice for the Storage and handling of dangerous goods” means the Storage and handling of dangerous goods, Code of Practice, Department of Mines and Petroleum, Government of Western Australia;

“m/s” mean metres per second;

“placard quantity” has the meaning defined in the Dangerous Goods Safety (Storage and Handling of Non-explosives) Regulations 2007; and

“severe rainfall event” means greater than a 1 in 100 year rainfall event of 72 hours duration.

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

#### DUST MANAGEMENT

1. The licensee shall use all reasonable and practical measures to prevent and where that is not practicable to minimise dust emissions from the premises.
2. The licensee shall ensure that all conveyor transfer points, including between belts and screens/crushers/storage facilities shall be operated and maintained such that dust emissions are minimised through the implementation of appropriate dust control measures.

#### STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

3. The licensee shall ensure that the plant grounds are drained such that, except for severe rainfall events, all surface water run-off is retained within the premises.

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### LIQUID CHEMICAL STORAGE

4. The licensee shall only store more than 250 kg or 250 litres of any substance that is classed as dangerous goods below placard quantities or environmentally hazardous materials not classified as dangerous goods if:
  - (a) they are stored in accordance with the Code of Practice for the Storage and handling of dangerous goods; and
  - (b) if secondary containment is required by 4(a), it is constructed and maintained to:
    - (i) contain not less than 110% of the volume of the largest storage vessel or inter-connected system; and
    - (ii) contain at least 25% of the total volume of vessels stored in the compound; and
    - (iii) have a low permeability ( $10^{-9}$  m/s or less)
  
5. The licensee shall immediately remove and dispose of any liquid resulting from spills or leaks of chemicals including fuel, oil or other hydrocarbons, whether inside or outside the low permeability compound(s), to a facility that is licensed or registered to accept such waste.

### REPORTING CONDITIONS

#### ANNUAL AUDIT COMPLIANCE REPORT

6. The licensee shall by **30 July** in each year, provide to the CEO an Annual Audit Compliance Report (AACR), indicating the extent to which the licensee has complied with the conditions of this licence, and any previous licence issued under Part V of the Act for the premises, during the period beginning **1 July** the previous year and ending on **30 June** in that year.

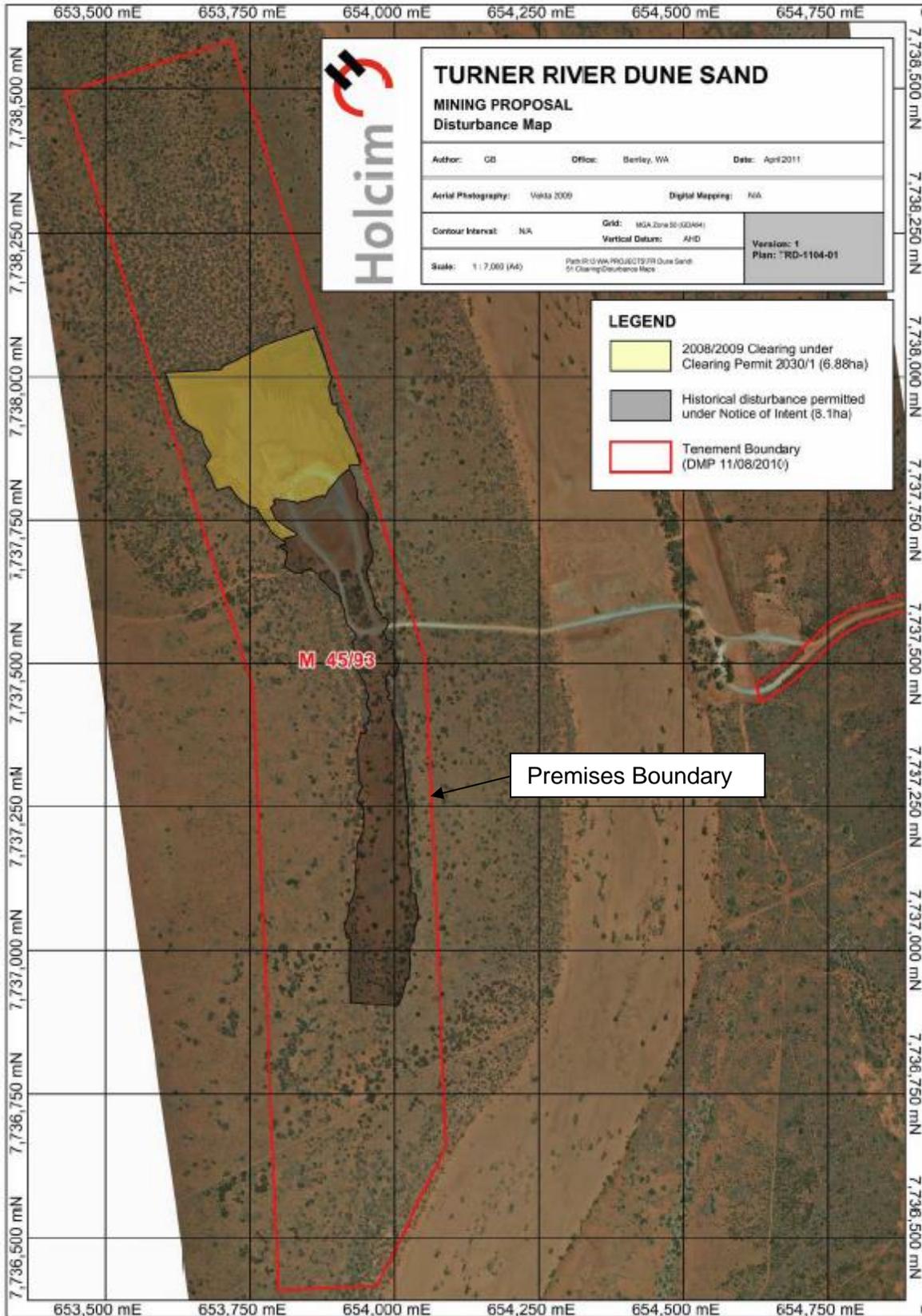
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### ATTACHMENT 1 - PLAN OF PREMISES (Premises boundary depicted in red)



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
