GENERAL CONDITIONS

SPILLAGES

- 1. The licensee shall ensure that any spillages of raw materials or finished product outside of any buildings on the premises are removed on a daily basis.
- 2. The licensee shall ensure that any raw material or finished product removed in accordance with Condition 1 of this licence is contained and stored such that it does not enter the environment.

EMISSION TO AIR

- 3. The licensee shall ensure that odour emitted from the premises does not unreasonably interfere with the health, welfare, convenience, comfort or amenity of any person who is not on the premises.
- 4. The licensee shall ensure that visible dust does not cross the boundary of the premises.
- 5. The licensee shall ensure that dust collection equipment, such as cyclones, are maintained on any air discharges prior to discharge to the environment.
- 6. The licensee shall ensure all stockpiles of raw materials held outdoors are covered.

EMISSION TO LAND

7. The licensee shall ensure that stormwater and process water is contained on the premises or is only discharged in extreme rainfall to the railway reserve.

NOISE

8. Noise emissions shall be verified within six months of the licence being issued.

COMPLAINTS

- 10. The Licensee shall keep a written record of all complaints received at the Premises. The record must provide the following (if known):

 - (iv) wind direction, wind speed and temperature at the time of the complaint;
 - (v) likely source of the reported problem; and
 - (vi) the corrective and preventative action undertaken in response to the complaint.

REPORTING CONDITIONS

ANNUAL MONITORING REPORT

- The Licensee shall provide to the CEO, by 30 June each year, one copy of an annual monitoring report containing data collected over the previous year and covering the period 1 June to 31 May. The report shall contain:
 - (i) details of the number and type of environmental complaints received, including the complainant's name (if known), address or location, nature of complaint (where appropriate cross-referenced with prevailing wind direction and operating conditions) and action taken in response to the complaint; and
 - (ii) details of any changes to site boundaries, processes, surface drainage channels and on-site or off-site impacts or pollution.

ANNUAL AUDIT COMPLIANCE REPORT


