Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

The following guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment

• *Guidance Statement: Licence Duration* (August 2016)

Amendment description

The Talloman Rendering Facility holds EP Act Licence L4297/1983/17 for Category 16: rendering operations and the Licence is due to expire on 30 September 2018. The CEO has decided to initiate an amendment to extend the duration of the current Licence for an additional 20 years from 30 September 2018 to 30 September 2038.

Decision

The extension of the Licence expiry date does not include any alteration to the production, design capacity or prescribed activity and therefore does not require a risk assessment in accordance with DWER's *Guidance Statement: Licence Duration*. In determining the duration of the Licence, the Delegated Officer has taken into account consent granted under other legislation, including development approval granted under the City of Swan's Local Planning Scheme dated 14 June 2006.

At the time of granting this Amendment Notice, the regulatory controls contained within the Licence are considered adequate to manage the day to day public health and environmental risk posed by the premises. In the future DWER intends to undertake a review of all licences, including the current Licence against the new risk assessment framework to ensure contemporary risk based pollution prevention, control and abatement outcomes are achieved.

The premises will be subject to ongoing compliance inspections and in the event that risk issues arise in relation to the site operation, the CEO may, depending on the circumstances: amend the conditions of licence at any time; or in the event of an alleged offence, exercise enforcement powers under the EP Act.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 25 September 2018. No comments were received from the Licence Holder.

Amendment

The licence duration has been extended from 30 September 2018 to 30 September 2038.
