## Amendment Notice

This notice is issued under section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

## Amendment Description

This notice is the result of a DER initiated amendment and relates to an extension of the licence expiry date.

## Decision

DER's *Guidance Statement on Licence Duration* provides for the granting of licences for up to 20 years duration. In 2016, DER implemented this guidance statement by extending the durations for most licensed prescribed premises.

The expiry date for this licence was not extended as part of this project, as DER had anticipated completing a review of the premises as part of the licence renewal in 2017.

DER has not been able to undertake this review prior to the 2017 licence expiry. The Delegated Officer has therefore determined to extend the expiry date by 12 months, which will enable both DER and the Licence Holder to undertake an ordered and structured review of the premises in accordance with DER's risk-based regulatory framework.
