Amendment Notice

This Notice is issued under section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act* 1986 (EP Act) to amend the Licence L6930/1986/12 issued under the EP Act for a Prescribed Premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B (9) of the EP Act.

Amendment description

During 2013, DWER completed a category 12 prescribed premises licence review which resulted in the current licence for the Boral Toodyay Hard Rock Quarry. The licence expires on Sunday 29 October 2017. On 10 August 2017, an application to renew licence L6930/1986/12 was submitted to DWER by the Licence Holder. DWER has completed a risk assessment of the premises emissions to determine any potential impacts on public health and the environment. The draft licence renewal documents were sent to the Licence Holder for review and comment.

The Licence Holder has raised concerns with the proposed changes to the licence and has requested more time to for discussions with DWER prior to finalizing the new licence.

DWER has initiated this amendment to the Licence L6930/1986/12 for the Boral Toodyay Hard Rock Quarry to provide sufficient time for the review to be completed.

The expiry date extension by three months will not alter the existing licence operations nor increase or alter existing authorised emissions.
