## Amendment Notice

This Notice is issued under section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

## Amendment Description

R.C.G. Pty Ltd (the Licence Holder) was granted an amended licence by DER on 28 April 2016 for the operation of Quinns Quarry facility. The Premises has a capacity of 100,000 per year for solid waste storage/sorting, between 50,000 to 500,000 tonnes per year for inert landfilling and up to 50,000 tonnes per year for screening activities.

The licence was due to be renewed in June 2016 however during the renewal process DER identified that the Licence Holder did not hold relevant planning approval for the premises activities. In accordance with DER's Guidance Statement: *Land Use Planning* (updated August 2016) DER will not grant a licence in the absence of planning approval. On 28 April 2016, the licence was amended to extend the licence duration for a period of six months (expiring 29 October 2016) to allow reasonable time for the Licence Holder to obtain planning approval.

On 14 October 2016, DER received a licence renewal application from the Licence Holder which included evidence that planning approval had been granted on 30 September 2016 for a period of five years.

This Amendment Notice is the result of a DER initiated amendment to extend the licence duration.

## Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined that an administrative amendment is to be made to extend the licence expiry date on page one of the licence due to insufficient time to process a new licence application before the current licence expires. The Delegated Officer has amended the licence expiry date for a period of five years to align with the approved planning expiry date. This is consistent with DER's Guidance Statement: *Licence Duration* (updated August 2016).

As part of this amendment, the Delegated Officer identified that the licence did not include a requirement to immediately cover asbestos waste. Table 1.2.3 of condition 1.2.6 has been amended to require asbestos to be covered immediately upon being received. The Delegated Officer considers this necessary to prevent risk of asbestos fibres being released and minimise risk of exposure to patrons during operating hours.

A detailed risk-assessment is not required as the amendment is administrative in nature. A licence amendment application to include prescribed premises category 13 (crushing operations) has been received by DER. The amendment to include crushing is being progressed and is subject to a detailed risk assessment.

In granting this amendment the Delegated Officer has considered the following DER guidance statements:
