Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited only to an amendment for Category 5 – change to the inspection frequency of the North Star Project Tailings Storage Facility (TSF). No other changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 5 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

The following guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment:

Amendment description

On 31 July 2018 IB Operations Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) submitted an application (IB Operations, July 2018) to amend the North Star Project operating licence L8845/2014/1. The Licence Holder has requested that the inspection frequency of the TSF be changed from daily to fortnightly (except during severe storm events) while operations at the site is undergoing a period of care and maintenance. No material has been processed through the Stage 1 ore processing facility since April 2017 and no tailings has been deposited since April 2017. There are no plans for further deposition in the near future.

An inspection audit of the TSF was carried out in December 2017 by environmental consultants Golder Associates. The audit found that the status of the TSF was 'operational readiness mode' and it was recommended that the inspection frequency be reduced to fortnightly except during severe storm events or when in operation. As a result of this audit the Licence Holder has sort this licence amendment.

The Licence Holder has requested the following amendments to Table 1.2.2 (shown in bold and underlined).

Decision

The Delegated Officer considers the risk to the environment from changing the inspection frequency of the TSF from daily to fortnightly while in care and maintenance to be low. The Licence Holder will be required to increase the frequency of inspections back to daily when the TSF reverts back to operation.

The Licence Holder's request to include a specification within Table 1.2.2 to require daily inspection of the TSF freeboard within 24 hours of a significant rainfall event has not been included as part of this amendment. Condition 1.2.2 (Table 1.2.1) of the Existing Licence requires the Licence Holder to maintain a minimum freeboard of 1000mm on the TSF regardless of whether the site is operating or in care and maintenance. It is up to the Licence Holder to remain compliant with this condition during significant rainfall events and therefore the Delegated Officer does not deem it necessary to specify this requirement within Condition 1.2.3 (Table 1.2.2).

The Delegated Officer considers that the Existing Licence has identified and assessed the environmental risk of potential emissions from the operation of the North Star TSF and that issue of this Amendment Notice will not adversely affect the risk rating of the Premises.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 12 September 2018. Comments received from the Licence Holder have been considered by the Delegated Officer as shown in Appendix 2.

Amendment

1. Condition 1.2.3 (Table 1.2.2) of the Licence is amended by the insertion of the bold text shown in underline below:

1.2.3 The Licensee shall:

- (a) undertake inspections as detailed in Table 1.2.2;
- (b) where any inspection identifies that an appropriate level of environmental protection is not being maintained, take corrective action to mitigate adverse environmental consequences as soon as practicable; and
- (c) maintain a record of all inspections undertaken.
