## **Amendment Notice**

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B (9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited only to an amendment of the licence duration. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Categories 12, 62, 64, 65 and 67A have been made in this amendment.

The following guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment:

- *Guidance Statement: Regulatory Principles* (July 2015)
- Guidance Statement: Licence Duration (August 2016)
- Guidance Statement: Decision Making (February 2017)

### **Amendment description**

This administrative amendment has been initiated by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) to extend the expiry date of the Licence. The Existing Licence has an expiry date of 18 May 2019. The licence is being amended to an expiry date of 18 May 2022 to allow for sufficient time for completion of changes to Ministerial Statements that have the potential to be progressed under Part IV of the EP Act.

An application to renew the licence will be required to be submitted prior to the new expiry date to extend the licence beyond 18 May 2022.

### Decision

The amendment is administrative only to extend the expiry date of the licence.

The Delegated Officer has considered the amendment and grants an extension to the licence duration to 18 May 2022.

DWER intends to undertake a detailed risk review of the licence to align the licence with the DWER's risk-based regulatory framework and consolidate any changes to the Ministerial Statements made following any decisions under Part IV of the EP Act. The risk-based review will commence prior to the renewal of the licence past 18 May 2022.

#### **Licence Holder's comments**

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 12April 2019. The Licence Holder responded on 2 May 2019 and opted to waive the comment period and requested that the licence be issued with no changes to the draft amendment.
