## Amendment Notice

This notice is issued under section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B (9) of the EP Act.

## Amendment Description

Current licence condition 3.1.1 requires the Licensee to submit a report on ambient groundwater monitoring by 30 September 2016 as required by IR1. The Licensee has requested that DER amend the submission date to 30 September 2017. Operations are yet to commence at the Premises.

## Decision

The submission date for IR1 has been amended to 30 September 2017. In addition, definitions and conditions have been updated in accordance with departmental reform. Conditions 1.1.5 and 4.1.2 have been deleted in accordance with DER *Guidance Statement: Setting Conditions* (October 2015), as the conditions are not valid, enforceable or risk-based.

- (c) discharge of waste in circumstances likely to cause pollution; or
- (d) being contrary to any written law.
