Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

As the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) has not yet completed the development of guidelines on the full reassessment of renewed licenses, the Delegated Officer intends to extend the licence expiry date for the premises. A full reassessment of the premises licence and operations will be considered on a risk-basis within the context of DWER's Licence Review Programme.

This notice is limited only to an amendment to the licence duration. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 62 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

The following guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment

- *Guidance Statement: Regulatory Principles* (July 2015)
- *Guidance Statement: Licence Duration* (August 2016)

Amendment description

The Existing Licence L8981/2016/1 was granted to the Western Metropolitan Regional Council (WMRC) on the 19 January 2018 for prescribed premises category 62 (solid waste depot) for the storage of green waste only. The Licence authorises up to 20,000 tonnes of green waste to be received and stored annually.

The Existing Licence was amended in 2018 to extend the licence duration to align with an extended lease agreement to 30 June 2019. On the 13 May 2019, the Licence holder provided evidence that they gained an extended lease agreement for another year, expiring 30 June 2020. This DWER initiated amendment Notice is limited only to an extension of the Existing licence duration to 30 June 2020 to align with the updated lease agreement for the premises.

Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined that an amendment be granted to extend the licence duration by a period of one year (expiring 30 June 2020) to align with the extended lease agreement.
