Works Approval Application – Rebecca Gold Project

AC Minerals Pty Ltd (AC Minerals) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Ramelius Resources Ltd (RMS). AC Minerals submits the following information in support of a Works Approval.

The project is located on granted mining tenement M28/400 and is a greenfield gold mining and processing project in the eastern Goldfields region, approximately 150 km east-northeast of Kalgoorlie. As a greenfield project all components need to be constructed to enable the project to commence. The project has been divided into two phases:

Phase 1 – an Early Works phase to construct the accommodation village, wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) and village landfill. This needs to occur first in order to establish the basic infrastructure needed to mobilise personnel to site to commence Phase 2, when all approvals for this phase have been obtained.

Phase 2 – Main project components comprising process plant, power station, open pit mines, tailings storage facility and remaining site infrastructure will be issued under a separate application.

This Works Approval application has been prepared to support the Phase 1 scope for the following Prescribed Premises categories:

- **Category 85.** Sewage facility: premises (a) on which sewage is treated (excluding septic tanks); or (b) from which treated sewage is discharged onto land or into waters. More than 20 but less than 100 cubic meters per day.
- **Category 89.** Putrescible landfill site: premises on which waste (as determined by reference to the waste type set out in the document entitled “Landfill Waste Classification and Waste Definitions 1996” published by the Chief Executive Officer, as amended from time to time) is accepted for burial. More than 20 but less than 5,000 tonnes per year
