## 1. Application summary

On 10 March 2022, after completing the licence renewal for Suez Recycling and Recovery (Perth) Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) at North Bannister Resource Recovery Park (The Premises) It was noted that due to a clerical error, the duration start date of the new licence had not been updated.

## 2. Regulatory framework

The Delegated Officer has determined to change only the duration start date of the licence and update the licence history therefore has not conducted a full review and risk assessment of emissions and discharges from the Premises in line with the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation's (department) *Work Instruction: Regulatory Services, COVID-19 licensing position* June 2021.

Under Section 59(1)(e) of the *Environmental Protection Act (1986)* the CEO may amend a licence by correcting a clerical mistake or unintentional error or omission.

## 3. Decision summary

Under the regulatory framework the Delegated Officer has determined to amend the licence L8871/2014/2 without conducting additional risk assessment of emissions.

As a result of this decision, a Licence L8871/2014/2 has been amended to reflect the new start date of the licence only.

## 4. Decision

Based on the information in this decision report, the Delegated Officer has determined that the Licence be amended.
