2.1. Purpose and scope of assessment

This is a DWER initiated amendment to correct an administrative error identified following the previous amendment to the Licence on 16 September 2019. A printing error occurred, and the incorrect sizing of the page holding the Premises Boundary map caused the map to be cut off.

This administrative amendment is to correct the page size to ensure the full Premises Boundary map is shown.

No other amendments to the Licence will be made at this time. No risk assessment is required.

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 11 October 2019 for review and comment. The Licence Holder responded on 29 October 2019. The following comments were received on the draft Amendment Report.

Definitions - Pollution	Fremantle Ports recommends that the definition of 'Pollution' be formatted to a separate line in the Definitions list.	The formatting error has been corrected.
Definitions – Trial	Fremantle Ports recommends that reference to 'Conditions 18 to 23' in the 'Trial' definition be changed to 'Conditions 12 to 17', to align with the relevant Schedule.	The referencing error has been corrected.
Condition 5	Fremantle Ports recommends that reference to 'Schedule 3' in Condition 5 be changed to 'Schedule 4' to align with the relevant Schedule.	The referencing error has been corrected.
Condition 16(b)	Fremantle Ports notes that 15-minute averaged meteorological (wind speed and direction) monitoring data is not collected (or available) at Kwinana Bulk Jetty and requests that Condition 16(b) be amended to require 30-minute averaged meteorological (wind speed and direction) monitoring data that can be assessed from nearby Bureau of Meteorology weather station 'Garden Island HSF (Station ID: 009256).	Accepted. The condition will be changed to require 30-minute averaged meteorological data. Note the requirements under 16(a) remain at 15-minute averages.
Schedule 1: Maps	Fremantle Ports notes the format change of Schedule 1 Maps to include the full Premises boundary.	Noted.
