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## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to transfer Licence L4511/1967/13. The amendment is administrative in nature therefore does not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Transfer Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision document for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In transferring the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Application summary

Licence L4511/1967/13 was held by Boral Bricks Western Australia Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for the Boral Bricks brickworks (the Premises), located in Middle Swan and Viveash at the lots recorded on the cover page of this report.

The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing or Licence L4511/1967/13.

On 22 July 2020, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to transfer Licence L4511/1967/13 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The change to the licence is limited only to updating the licence holder details as follows:

## 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Transfer Report on 5 October 2020. The Licence Holder provided comments on 7 October 2020, waiving the remaining review period and requesting that the licence transfer be issued as soon as possible. One typographic error was identified in form AR1 which was corrected.

## 4. Conclusion

The Delegated Officer determined that the transfer of the Licence is an administrative amendment which does not alter the risk profile of the premises. Following review of the ASIC company details and documentation regarding authority to access the premises, the Delegated Officer transferred the Licence to Capitary No. 3 Pty Ltd. The Premises shall continue to operate in accordance with the original Licence conditions and regulatory requirements.

implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
