1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L5973/1992/12. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L5973/1992/12, issued on 31 October 2023, is held by Water Corporation (Licence Holder) for the Pinjarra Water Resource Recovery Facility (the Premises). The Premises is located at Lot 19 on Diagram 44739 Adelaide Road, Oakley WA.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in the existing Licence L5973/1992/12.

On 27 November 2023, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L5973/1992/12. The amendment is limited to correcting an administrative error – i.e. Condition 13 on the existing Licence should be set out as two separate conditions (Conditions 13 and 14).

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report and draft Licence on 15 December 2023. On 18 December 2023 the Licence Holder advised they have no comments regarding the draft licence and requested the licence to be issued as soon as possible. This has been noted by the Delegated Officer.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments
