2. Amendment Description

The amendment is limit to the transfer of Licence L7102/1997/8 from Cleanaway Pty Ltd to the City of Bayswater. This request was made at the request of the City of Bayswater.

The following guidance statements have informed the assessment and decision outlined in this Amendment Report:

2.1 **Purpose and scope of assessment**

The assessment of the transfer application is limited to a review of ownership details to determine if a Licence transfer may occur and minor administrative corrections. There are no proposed changes to the current approved Premises categories or design capacity.

2.2 Revision of Licence

As part of this Licence transfer, DWER has updated the licence with minor administrative corrections and reformatting of the Licence to the current DWER template.

The obligations of the Licence Holder have not materially changed in the revision of the Licence. DWER has not undertaken any additional risk assessment of the Premises related to previous Amendment Notices.

In consolidating the licence, DWER has:

- Updated the format and appearance of the Licence;
- Amalgamated Licence amendment notices;
- Deleted the redundant Annual Audit Compliance Report form set out in schedule 1 of the previous Licence and advise the Licence Holder to obtain the form from the department's website;
- Deleted the redundant N1 form set out in schedule 1 of the previous Licence;
- Revised Licence condition's numbers, and removed any redundant conditions and realigned condition numbers for numerical consistency;
- Reformatted remaining conditions;
- Corrected clerical mistakes and unintentional errors; and
- Made minor changes to certain conditions, with the addition of reporting and notification timeframes.
