1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L7120/1997/12 relating to the ongoing acceptance of small quantities of household hazardous waste. The acceptance of small quantities of Household hazardous waste has already been assessed and found acceptable in the Existing Licence Decision Report, however the acceptance was not explicitly authorised in the licence. .

The amendments are therefore considered administrative in nature as they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing Licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://www.der.wa.gov.au>.

2.2 Application summary

Licence L7120/1997/12 is held by the City of Busselton (Licence Holder) for the Rendezvous Road Transfer Station (the Premises), located at 39 Rendezvous Road, VASSE, WA, 2680.

The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in Existing Licence L7120/1997/12.

On 19 May 2020, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L7120/1997/12 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to the inclusion of acceptance of small quantities of household chemicals (<20litres or <20kg) to align with the Dunsborough site licence (L9167/2018/1). The acceptance of small quantities of household hazardous waste has already been assessed and found acceptable in the Existing Licence Decision Report.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 08 July 2020. On 08 July 2020 the Licence Holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments
