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1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L7210/1997/10. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59(1) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L7210/1997/10 is held by MUSHROOMEXCHANGE PTY LTD (licence holder) for the Mushroom Exchange composting facility (the premises), located at Lot 89 on Deposited Plan 741.

The premises relates to the category 67A and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L7210/1997/10.

The department has initiated an amendment to licence L7210/1997/10. The amendment is limited to extending the licence expiry date only as the department considers there to be insufficient time to complete the licence amendment (APP-0031106) prior to the current licence expiry. Therefore, the licence duration will be extended for a short period to ensure the current licence continues to remain in force until an assessment is able to be completed. The licence holder will submit a renewal application for a full assessment of the licence after the amendment is granted.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 9 April 2026. On 10 April 2026 the licence holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the delegated officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
