1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L7303/1998/10. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

1.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

1.2 Amendment summary

Licence L7303/1998/10 is held by Western Metropolitan Regional Council (Licence Holder) for the West Metro Recycling Centre (the Premises), located at 60 Lemnos Street, Shenton Park WA.

The Premises relates to Category 62: Solid waste depot and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L7303/1998/10.

The department considers there to be insufficient time to complete a licence renewal prior to the current licence expiry. Therefore, the licence duration will be extended for a short period to ensure the current licence continues to remain in force until a full assessment is able to be completed.

On 10 July 2024, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L7303/1998/10. The amendment is limited to extending licence expiry date; addition of date of issue to cover page, annual reporting period, deletion of annual environmental reporting requirements, deletion of N1 form and updating of definitions.

2. Consultation

On 1 August 2024 the Licence Holder waived the comment period.

3. Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the amendment process.
