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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L8778/2013/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing Licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8778/2013/1 is held by North West Quarries Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for the Pippingarra Quarry Site (the Premises), located at Mining Tenement M45/258 and General Purpose Leases G45/329, G45/330, G45/47, G45/48, G45/52, G45/53, G45/54, G45/56, G45/58, G45/59, G45/60, G45/61.

The Premises relates to the category 12 and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L8778/2013/1.

On 10 September 2020, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L87778/2013/1. The amendment is limited to:

- updating occupier's registered company address;
- · updating premises address;
- · replacing/deleting redundant conditions;
- · correcting typographical errors; and
- updating/deleting/including definitions.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 8 October 2020.

On 16 October 2020 the Licence Holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
