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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to renew Licence L9029/2017/1 which expires on 27 March 2024. The licence renewal changes are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Decision Report documents the changes made to the renewed licence pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

When renewing the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at DWER Regulatory documents | Western Australian Government (www.wa.gov.au).

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L9029/2017/2 is held by Karora (Higginsville) Pty Ltd (licence holder) for the Mt Henry Project (the premises), located on tenement 63/515, L63/64 and G63/7 at Norseman.

The premises relates to the category and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L9029/2017/2.

An application was received on 29 December 2023 requesting the department initiate renewal of Licence L9029/2017/2. The licence changes are limited to the licence duration, reduced licence expiry date, converting licence to latest licence format and correcting typographical errors.

The licence renewal extends the duration of the licence by 36 months to allow the department further time to consider whether the risk profile of emissions and discharges from the premises has been adequately addressed by the current risk assessment and licence conditions. Following this review, if changes are required, the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) will amend the conditions relating to emissions and discharges.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft licence and decision report on 16 February 2024. On 26 and 27 February 2024, the licence holder requested the licence duration be extended to 2027 as operations are likely to remain in care and maintenance in the next 12 to 18 months and considered a one-year licence to be unmanageable. The Delegated Officer agreed to extend the licence duration to 2027.

A copy of the licence was also sent to the Department of Biodiversity Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) who replied on 21 February 2024 asking the Premises boundary to be adjusted to exclude the Brockway Timber Reserve. This was noted and Premise map in schedule 1 of the licence was adjusted.

The Shire of Dundas (SoD) and Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DEMIRS) had no comments.

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4. Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined that a licence renewal shall be granted to extend the licence duration by 36 months. The short-term extension is to allow sufficient time for the department to conduct a comprehensive licence review and assess the risks to public health and the environment associated with emissions and discharges from the Premises.

In granting this renewal the Delegated Officer has also determined that the licence be converted into the latest DWER licence format and that Schedule 2 and 3 monitoring requirements be included as licence conditions within the body of the licence. Table 1 describes the changes proposed and including the replacement of outdated conditions, removal of redundant conditions and typographical errors. These changes have been documented in Section 5.1 table 1.

All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the licence renewal process.

5. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Decision Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that a renewed licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

5.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the licence renewal process.
