## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W2999/2025/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Works Approval W2999/2025/1 is held by Greenmount Resources Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Karlawinda Gold Project (the Premises), located in the Shire of Meekatharra approximately 56 kilometres south-east of Newman.

The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W2999/2025/1

On 23 April 2026, the department initiated an amendment to Works Approval W2999/2025/1. The amendment is limited to correct typographical errors and renumbering of conditions on the granted works approval.

## 3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 7 May 2026. On 7 May 2026 the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period for the proposed amendment.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments
