## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6301/2019/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6301/2019/1 is held by Tronox Management Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Chandala Mineral Separation Plant (the Premises), located at part of Lot M1261 on Diagram 5326.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6301/2019/1.

On 13 September 2022, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6301/2019/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending the works approval expiry date until 8 December 2027. The expiry date has been extended to allow the Works Approval Holder more time to complete the works approved in this instrument.



### 3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 4 November 2022. On 7 November 2022 the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period.

### 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

#### 4.1 Summary of amendments
