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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to works approval W6640/2022/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Works approval W6640/2022/1 is held by Aurene Mit Pty Ltd (works approval holder) for the Mt Ida Gold Project, Bottle Creek Premises (the premises), located in Ularring, Western Australia. The works approval, granted on 21 June 2022, relates to categories 5, 7 and 64 and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing works approval W6640/2022/1.

On 16 September 2025, the department initiated an amendment to works approval W6640/2022/1. The amendment is limited to extending works approval expiry date and extending the time limited operations period. This is to allow for the assessment of the new licence to operate the infrastructure currently within time limited operations on the premises. The new licence was applied for on 15 September 2025.

Under condition 19 of the works approval, the time limited operation period is due to end 30 November 2025 and the works approval is set to expire on 19 December 2025. To continue construction and operations, complete reporting obligations and transition infrastructure to a new licence, the department has initiated an amendment to:

- Extend the time-limited operations by 180 days, with a new end date of 28 May 2026; and
- Extend the works approval expiry date of the works approval by 12 months, with the new expiry set for 19 December 2026.

3. Consultation

The works approval holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 7 October 2025. No comments were received from the works approval holder.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
