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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6968/2024/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6968/2024/1 is held by ICD Superalloys Australia Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Canning Vale Facility (the Premises), located at Warehouse B, 204-208 Bannister Road, Canning Vale.

The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6968/2024/1.

On 3 October 2025, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6968/2024/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited to extending time limited operations for an additional 90 days (to 20 January 2025), to allow for the continued operation of the facility to allow sufficient time for DWER to validate, advertise and assess the application for the new licence which was submitted 20 August 2025.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 14 October 2025. On 15 October 2025 the Works Approval waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised works approval as part of the amendment process.
