Alcoa contracts an independent stack emission testing company, who are accredited by the National Association of Testing Authorities, Australia (NATA), to undertake stack emission monitoring for Alcoa's compliance with the relevant licence conditions.

After a review initiated by Alcoa, Alcoa identified that the stack emission testing company has used its expertise to independently apply procedural modifications to certain elements of the testing methods contained in the licence. Alcoa is currently reviewing if the procedural modifications to the testing methods meet the requirements for those methods.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

Date(s) of noncompliance: 29 July 2020 and around 24 September 2020

Details of non-compliance:

- 1. On 29 July 2020, there was an unexpected cloth failure on the #5 Filter in the Filtration Facility whilst the filter was undergoing a compression cycle. Residue slurry was unexpectedly released from the filter under high pressure. About 5kL of slurry exited the Filtration Facility via a ventilation vent and contacted unsealed ground around the Facility. The spill was cleaned up immediately and the impacted fill replaced. The ventilation vent was subsequently sealed, and Alcoa is reviewing options to install additional sealing around the Filtration Facility. The event did not cause pollution or environmental harm.
- 2. On 24 September 2020, an Alcoa employee identified a small area outside of the Filtration Facility where it appeared that washdown water containing residue solids from within the Facility had contacted unsealed ground near Sub Station 10Z. The spill, which was estimated to be less than 20L, was cleaned up immediately. Additional training in correct clean up procedures has been undertaken with the Filtration Facility operators, and signage has been installed in the facility. The event did not cause pollution or environmental harm

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

Neither event caused pollution or environmental harm.

Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

- 1. Unexpected cloth failure on the #5 Filter in the Filtration Facility whilst the filter was undergoing a compression cycle.
- 2. Operator oversight when undertaking cleaning duties.

Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:

For both events, Alcoa undertook immediate cleanup of the spilt material and disposal of impacted fill.

Alcoa has sealed the ventilation vent on the Filtration Facility structure and is also investigating options to install additional sealing around the Filtration Facility. Alcoa has provided additional training of operators in correct cleaning procedures and installed signs in the Filtration Facility relating to containing the material during cleaning.
