Water quality samples were collected as required by Condition 16. Measurements for total suspended solids (TSS) were above target in Q1 and Q4, although turbidity is highly variable at this site due to significant livestock presence. Surface water runoff is greatest in Q4 and Q1 (wet season) which also impacts turbidity. Measurements taken in Q2 and Q3 were within target. Measurements for iron were also above target for Q1. As this sampling site is primarily drainage from the processing plant, this is not unusual. All other analytes sampled were within target. Full annual laboratory results are listed in Appendix 1, Table 4 of the accompanying AER.

Instrument issues caused by frequent damage from fauna activity, resulted in inaccurate recordings between October and December 2023. Livestock are active at the Paraburdoo mine site due to the operating pastoral station nearby.
