
Details of non-compliance:

Licence condition 3.4.1 requires standing water levels (SWL) be taken quarterly for TSF3 monitoring bores (CTDP2D, TRB001, T3MB1, T3MB2, T3MB4, T3MB5, T3MB6, T3RB01, T3MB07, T3MB8, T3MB9 & T3MB10). Upon review of monitoring data, no record of TSF3 monitoring bores SWL data could be found for the month of December 2023 (Q2). Noting the presence of other monitoring data for these bores, including field pH, EC and temperature, as well as lab sample analysis, it seems unlikely that SWL was missed and rather the data records were lost.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

Data taken in September 2023 (Q1) and March 2024 (Q3) shows little variation, with majority of bores showing a slight decrease in SWL. No environmental impact is expected as a result of the loss of records for TSF3 monitoring bores.



Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

Turnover of staff and introduction of new monitoring data management systems implemented is likely to have been the result of the lost data records.
