#### Details of non-compliance:

Condition 5b requires "discharge of leachate, treated wastewater or untreated wastewater (such as via direct discharge, overtopping or seepage) from the water resource recovery facility shall not occur".

Overtopping of the inlet works occurred on the following dates during the 2024-2025 reporting period:

- 6 September 2024 Overflow of approximately 240kL of untreated wastewater from the inlet works.
- 7 September 2024 Overflow of approximately 130kL of untreated wastewater from the inlet works.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

The majority of the overflow was contained with the bitumen hard surface area and the on-site soak wells. An estimated 15% of the discharge flowed down the access driveway, then into a piped stormwater pit which eventually discharges to the emergency infiltration beds. An environmental risk assessment was completed and the overall risk of this event was deemed Low

Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

Due to a faulty inlet valve and decanter surface probe within the sequence batch reactors.

Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:

#### Section E – Details of non-compliance with licence condition

The following actions were taken to mitigate any adverse effects and to prevent recurrence:

- The faulty inlet valve was repaired on the 12/09/2024.
- Frequency of inspection and maintenance of surface water probes has been increased.
- All surface probes have been replaced.
- An investigation to install an emergency inlet valve bypass has been initiated by the Water Corporation (ADR# 32038).
- Pooling wastewater was recovered via vacuum tanker trucks (55kL).
- Bitumen hard stand area washed and disinfectant applied.
