Category 63 – Class 1 inert landfill site	703.5m3 or 914.55 tonnes of inert waste were received and buried on-site at the Facility during the reporting period. This is a subtle decrease (approximately 232m3 volume of inert waste) in volume from the previous year as demolition and re-building work continues but at a slower rate to repair damage caused when Cyclone Seroja devastated the Shire on 11th April 2021. This decrease in the volume of inert waste received was expected, and we expect it to continue to decrease over the next year. The Shire applied for and was granted an increase in the Facility Licence Approved Premises Production or Design Capacity for this waste category to not more than 3,600 tonnes per annual period for a 2 year period.
