

pH of emission wastewater was lower than the condition limits

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

Low pH emission to land may cause acidification and compaction of soil profile.

Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

The cause of wastewater pH low is mainly wine lees or juice lees during production. The main period of the non-compliance happened was during vintage time when juice clarification and grape pressings happened. The acid from grape drained into the wastewater system and had not been properly neutralized.

Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:

- Add caustic soda to aeration tank to buffer the pH
- Spread limestone onto irrigation area to prevent acidification of soil in future if soil pH test is out
 of range
- A new pH monitoring and adjusting system is purchased and will be installed on arrival to buffer wastewater pH
- Future proposed volumetric flow meter for LAA blocks on irrigation controller to be installed to manage emission to soil better and pause irrigation if not within specifications
