Details of non-compliance:

The site is licensed as a Category 23 Animal Feed Manufacturing Site and has a licenced production capacity of 150,000 tons per annum.

Production volumes for the 2019 – 2020 season have exceeded this by 10,233 tons. The increased volume was due to the need to provide continued assistance to farm and feedlot owners affected by the ongoing drought and subsequent bush fires during the first few months of the reporting period in parts of Queensland, Victoria and New South Wales and help avoid animal welfare issues.

This non-compliance only relates to an over-production of our annual license approval and there were no environmental impacts as a result of this excess. Our Mill works all available hours and we achieve the additional capacity by and large by changing formulations to ones that mill faster (higher grain input) and optimising throughput on drought type feeds.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

The non-compliance only related to an excess of the approved annual throughput for production and that there were no environmental impacts relating to this exceedance.

Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

Ongoing severe drought and bush fires during the first few months of the reporting period in parts of Queensland, Victoria and New South Wales in supplying additional feed to help avoid animal welfare issues.

Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:

At present we are milling at a rate per week that will keep us within the licensed capacity but seasonal conditions in WA in the first half of next year could increase demand above that rate.
