Discharge of approximately 300L of untreated wastewater from the Biomax wastewater treatment plant near PC2 Go-Line 4.

No actual or suspected adverse impact on the environment occurred as a result of this non-compliance discharge. All wastewater was contained and cleaned up.



#### Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

Failure of the discharge pump and blower when the genset power was switched to permanent power and having the phases reversed. This caused polarity and burnt out the motor and in turn has caused untreated wastewater to spill onto the ground.

Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:

Spill was contained, cleaned up and barricaded off with signage to prevent unauthorized access.

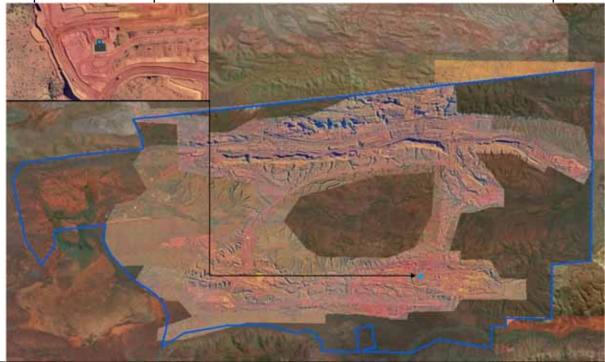

The requirements for regular monitoring at this location were unexpectedly removed from the program of works. This omission was not identified and rectified until Q4 FY2022.

Water monitoring was completed once the omission was identified, and the monitoring location was reinstated to the monitoring program. Direct engagement completed with the monitoring team to confirm reinstatement and recommencement of monitoring, and review completed of internal verification processes to ensure regular verification of monitoring program completion occurs.
