DDG 11 indicated a total insoluble solids level of 5 was 7.5 g/m2/month against a licence target of 4 g/m2/month. The recorded nickel content was 190  $\mu$ g/sample or 6.8 mg/m2/month.

# Section E – Details of Non-Compliance with Licence Condition




Figure 1: Wind-rose for Merch 2020 monitoring period

A review of wind data taken from the RNO orisite weather station shows that winds for March were predominantly from the south and the east, north east and south east. Figure 1 below, shows the wind speed distribution by wind direction for the March monitoring period. The strongest winds were from the east, north east and south east as would be expected.

at the time of year.

Given the prevailing wind directions for March and the fact that other DDGs located around the mining and processing areas did not exceed the target, in particular DDG12 (1.5 mg/m2/month), located between the Tailings Storage Facility (TSF) and DDG11, it is unclear what has caused the target exceedance.

The weather station data for the March monitoring period are included with this report.
