There were no recorded exceedances for ambient SO ₂ during the reporting period July 2023 – June 2024 at the licenced ambient monitoring stations. 1-hour average ambient SO ₂ levels throughout the reporting period were significantly below the ambient air quality target of 200 ppb as prescribed in Condition 3.5.3 and Table 3.5.2 of L8326/2008/5.
